Subject: Report Regarding Security Cameras in County Parks

The following is provided in response to a directive from Commissioner Javier D. Souto at the May 11, 2009, Recreation, Culture and Tourism Committee (RCTC) meeting for the Park and Recreation Department (MDPR) Director to provide the RCTC with a report identifying where security cameras are mounted in Tropical Park and other regional parks throughout the County.

Closed Circuit Television Cameras (CCTV Cameras) were mounted in Tropical, Goulds and Tamiami Parks in conjunction with the Mayor's wireless initiative. Originally two cameras were placed within Tropical Park; currently four cameras are on order and to be installed by the Enterprise Technology Services Department that will provide camera coverage throughout the park. The CCTV cameras at Tamiami Park are in place and currently undergoing a repair to their power supply. The CCTV Cameras installed at Goulds Park are operational. Additional deployments of CCTV cameras are planned for Crandon and Haulover Parks to help monitor toll operations only. MDPR has also installed cameras at Miami MetroZoo and Women's Park.
