

**Subject:** Resolution Approving Significant Modification of *Building Better Communities* Bond Program Project No. 233 – “Miami Beach Convention Center”

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the attached resolution which approves a significant modification to the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond Program (BBC-GOB) Project No. 233 listed in Resolution No. R-917-04 (Authorizing Resolution). The significant modification would change the project description and correct the street address of the project, as agreed upon by the City of Miami Beach and County in an agreement signed in December 2003 and was the intent of the ballot question. The BBC-GOB funding for this project is not impacted and remains at \$55 million.

## Scope

The project is located in County Commission District 5, but has a countywide and regional impact.

There is no fiscal impact based on this recommendation and the project is funded from the BBC-GOB funds.

The implementing agency will be the City. The responsible party for the contract monitoring aspects of this project is Johnny Martinez, P.E., Director of the Office of Capital Improvements.

There is no additional delegation of authority related to this item.

## Background


On November 2, 2004 voters overwhelmingly approved the eight referendum questions to fund more than 300 capital improvements throughout the County over the next 15 to 18 years. Each ballot question included a list of projects defined in Appendix “A” eligible for funding from the BBC-GOB by number, name and project description. All additions, deletions and significant modifications to individual projects require a majority vote of the Board following a public hearing. One of the projects included in the BBC-GOB is Project No. 223 “Miami Beach Convention Center.”

In March 2004, the County and City of Miami Beach entered into the second amendment to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated June 21, 1996 wherein the County agreed to include in the 2004 BBC-GOB initiative presented to the voters funding “for a project related to the expansion and

enhancement of the Miami Beach Convention Center." In addition, the street address shown in the 2004 BBC-GOB initiative (1700 Convention Center Drive) was incorrect. Therefore, it is requested that the street address for the convention center be changed to 1901 Convention Center Drive.

On June 25, 2009, the BBC-GOB Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC), one member short of a quorum, agreed by consensus of the nine members present that this item should be forwarded for consideration by the Board with a favorable recommendation.

There is an accompanying item on this agenda requesting approval of an interlocal agreement with the City for the Miami Beach Convention Center project.
