Subject: Request to Reject all Bids for the One-Year Countywide Contract for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Cured-in-Place Pipe Lining Method with County Option to Renew for an Additional Three Years on a Yearly Basis - Project No: N/A; Contract No: S-838

RECOMMENDATION

This request to reject all bids for construction Contract No. S-838 has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and is recommended for approval. Six bids were received for the contract on April 28, 2009. An addendum to the contract was issued, in error, on April 17, 2009 which restricts eligibility only to bidders with liner curing facilities located in Miami-Dade County or Broward County. It is not in the best interest of the County to limit participation only to bidders with facilities in Miami-Dade or Broward counties, therefore it is recommended to reject the bids received and to re-advertise.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to repair approximately 46,000 linear feet of eight inch through 24-inch diameter gravity sanitary sewer pipe under different work orders by the cured-in-place pipe lining method at different locations anywhere within the limits of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as ordered by WASD during a one year period. This is a non-exclusive contract. WASD may issue similar contracts for this type of work, therefore it does not guarantee that the full amount of the contract work listed in the proposal will be issued to the contractor. The amount of work orders assigned is at WASD's discretion, on an as needed basis.

The work will also include the following: restoration of approximately 550 service laterals, including sealing the lateral connections, cleaning and video inspections, supplementary cleaning of the sewers to be repaired, removal and proper disposal of solids as required, bypass pumping of sewage, maintenance of traffic (MOT), and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items and work for a completed project.

The unit prices bid will be used for uniform comparison amongst the bidders and the bids will be evaluated based upon the lowest bid dollar amount. The contract will be awarded for

an aggregate amount up to \$2,300,000 for a 12-month period. The contract will terminate upon the depletion of the \$2,300,000 or the expiration of the 12-month period, whichever occurs first.

It is WASD's intent to obtain a complete functional, and satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.

WASD recommends rejecting the bids received and to re-advertise so that competition is not limited.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS EXCEED LEGAL REQUIREMENTS: Yes - The minimum qualifications exceed the legal requirements, but the small business community will not be impacted since there are no firms available within that group that can perform this work. The requirements represent the absolute minimum for the work to be done properly according to industry standards and requirements by comparable local governments.
