**Subject:** Resolution Authorizing a Transfer of Jurisdiction to the Town of Medley, Approving the Official Right-of-Way Map for a Portion of NW 122 Street between NW 107 Avenue and NW 117 Avenue, and Authorizing the Recording Thereof Among the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution authorizing a transfer of jurisdiction to the Town of Medley, approving the official Right-of-Way Map for a portion of NW 122 Street between NW 107 Avenue to NW 117 Avenue, and authorizing the recording thereof among the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The Public Works Department (PWD) Director recommends approval of this jurisdictional transfer.

## **Scope**

The portion of NW 122 Street to be transferred to the Town of Medley is located within Commission District 12.

## **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this transfer.

## **Track Record/Monitor**

Not applicable.

## **Background**

The Town of Medley has a project underway to replace the grade-crossing at NW 107 Ave/NW 122 Street of the existing Florida East Coast Railroad tracks with an elevated intersection (flyover ramp) to avoid a difficult crossing. The North half of the public road right-of-way is already under the jurisdiction of the Town of Medley. Therefore, in order to secure the right-of-way needed for the project under the same jurisdiction, the Town's Attorney formally requested a transfer of jurisdiction by mutual consent in a letter dated July 13, 2009 to the Miami-Dade County PWD Director for the South half of the public road right-of-way. The PWD Director has no objection with the aforementioned jurisdictional transfer and it is therefore recommended that the attached Road Right-of-Way Map be approved by the BCC, recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, after which it will be transferred to the Town of Medley.

Both the original tracing and the Mylar reproducible of the Road Right-of-Way Map are to be attested by the Deputy Clerk of the Board on behalf of the BCC and returned to the PWD for recording in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION TO THE TOWN OF MEDLEY, APPROVING THE OFFICIAL RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP FOR A PORTION OF NW 122 STREET BETWEEN NW 107 AVENUE AND NW 117 AVENUE, AND AUTHORIZING THE RECORDING THEREOF AMONG THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FLORIDA

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County Public Works Department has recommended that an official Right-of-Way Map be approved and filed for record to transfer jurisdiction and ownership, pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 335.0415 and 337.29 of the Florida Statutes, to the Town of Medley,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby:

1. Approves the transfer of jurisdiction between Miami-Dade County (County) and the Town of Medley (Town), pursuant to Chapters 335.0415 and 337.29 of the Florida Statutes, providing for the Town to assume the jurisdiction, ownership, maintenance and control of that portion of NW 122 Street between NW 107 Avenue and NW 117 Avenue, being legally described in Exhibit "A" and depicted in Exhibit "B" of this resolution. This transfer of jurisdiction includes the rights and responsibilities of the Town to maintain the right-of-way infrastructure excepting traffic devices. The Town

assumes liability for these rights and responsibilities. The County shall retain responsibility for regulation of traffic and shall reserve the right to make any regulatory and design determinations appurtenant traffic control including but not limited to installation and/or regulation of traffic signals, signs, pavement markings, road closings and traffic calming measures.

2. Approves the official Right-of-Way Map for that portion of NW 122 Street between NW 107 Avenue and NW 117 Avenue being transferred.
3. Authorizes the Deputy Clerk of this Board to sign said Right-of-Way Map and affix thereto the Seal of this Board, for and behalf of Miami-Dade County; to cause said instrument to be recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.
4. Authorizes the Director of the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department to cause said recorded instrument to be delivered to the Town of Medley.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner
