RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD'S  
CO-DESIGNATION OF SW 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE FROM SW 320<sup>TH</sup>  
STREET TO SW 328<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS "ERNESTINE SEYMORE  
BLVD."

**WHEREAS**, on July 14, 2009, the City Council of the City of Homestead adopted Resolution No. R2009-07-77, which designated SW 4th Avenue from SW 320<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 328<sup>th</sup> Street as "Ernestine Seymore Blvd.," in recognition of her contributions to the City of Homestead, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 320<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 328<sup>th</sup> Street is a city street located in the City of Homestead; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Homestead wants the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 9,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Homestead's co-designation of SW 4th Avenue from SW 320<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 328<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Homestead as "Ernestine Seymore Blvd."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Homestead, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the

Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

**RESOLUTION NO. R2009-07-77**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, CODESIGNATING SW 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN SW 328<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND SW 320<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS "ERNESTINE SEYMORE BLVD." IN HONOR OF HOMESTEAD TEACHER AND LIFE LONG RESIDENT ERNESTINE SEYMORE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Ernestine Seymore has made substantial contributions to South Miami-Dade and Homestead communities;

**WHEREAS**, an application made on behalf of Ernestine Seymore for a street to be co-designated in her name has been reviewed and recommended to the City Council of the City of Homestead by the Homestead/Florida City Human Relations Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Human Relations Board shall contribute four hundred dollars (\$400.00) to offset the costs associated with the fabrication and installation of a sign co-designating a street in the name of Ernestine Seymore; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Homestead has accepted the recommendation of the Human Relations Board to acknowledge Ernestine Seymore for her contributions by co-designating a street in her name.

**WHEREAS**, this request is pursuant to the City of Homestead Policy for Naming, Renaming, or Codesignation of City of Homestead Streets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** In recognition of the outstanding dedication and valuable contributions rendered by Ernestine Seymore to the citizens of Homestead and South Miami-Dade County, the City of Homestead formally codesignates SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue

between SW 328<sup>th</sup> Street (Lucy Street) and SW 320<sup>th</sup> Street (W Mowry Dr.), as "Ernestine Seymore Blvd.", in perpetuity, in honor of Ernestine Seymore.

**Section 2.** That the appropriate departments of the City of Homestead are hereby authorized and directed to erect the appropriate street signs, subject to any and all necessary coordination with or approval from Miami-Dade County.

**Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption hereof, and the purchase is hereby authorized.


