RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE
AND OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO ENFORCE
EXPRESSWAY SIGN ORDINANCE WITHIN
MUNICIPALITIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 33-82 and 33-121.11 of the Code of Miami Dade County, Florida, the zoning regulations pertaining to outdoor signs are applicable to both the unincorporated and incorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 33-121.12., outdoor signs may not be placed within 600 feet of an expressway (the “protected area”), except in those municipalities that have elected to opt out of that prohibition in accordance with such section,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor or his designee and the Office of the County Attorney are hereby directed to utilize appropriate means to enforce the zoning regulations pertaining to outdoor signs in the protected area adjacent to expressways within municipalities.
