

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION BY  
THE CITY OF MIAMI OF SW 25<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE FROM SW 7<sup>TH</sup>  
STREET TO SW 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS “MANOLO CAPÓ WAY”

**WHEREAS**, on July 23, 2009, the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution R-09-0382, which designated SW 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street as “Manolo Capó Way,” in recognition of his contributions to the City of Miami, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 5,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the co-designation by the City of Miami of SW 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street as “Manolo Capó Way.”

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING SOUTHWEST 25TH AVENUE FROM SOUTHWEST 7TH STREET TO SOUTHWEST 8TH STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "MANOLO CAPO WAY;" FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INSTRUCT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Southwest 25th Avenue from Southwest 7th Street to Southwest 8th Street, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Manolo Capo Way".

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to instruct the Director of Public Works to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, Miami-Dade County Public Works, and the United States Postal Service.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}

Footnotes:

{1} If the Mayor does not sign this Resolution, it shall become effective at the end of ten calendar days from the date it was passed and adopted. If the Mayor vetoes this Resolution, it shall become effective immediately upon override of the veto by the City Commission.


The City of Miami Commission has adopted the attached resolution authorizing a co-designation for the following streets:
