

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 147TH AVENUE FROM SW 104TH STREET TO SW 118TH STREET AS “SERGEANT MARCEL J. PALAU AVENUE”

WHEREAS, Sergeant Marcel J. Palau was born in Los Angeles, California and moved to Miami where he graduated from South Miami Senior High School in 1986; and

WHEREAS, in June 1989, Sergeant Palau joined the Miami-Dade Police Department as a Public Service Aide and later became a Police Officer in September 1996; and

WHEREAS, among Sergeant Palau’s assignments were the Kendall and South Districts and the Professional Compliance Bureau, receiving an overall rating of Outstanding during the past ten years; and

WHEREAS, in July 2008, Sergeant Palau received a certificate from the Federal Bureau of Investigations for his outstanding assistance in a joint investigative effort; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Marcel J. Palau passed away on August 1st, 2009; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Sergeant Marcel J. Palau with this co-designation; and

WHEREAS, SW 147th Avenue from SW 104th Street to SW 118th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed co-designation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 147th Avenue from SW 104th Street to SW 118th Street as “Sergeant Marcel J. Palau Avenue.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
