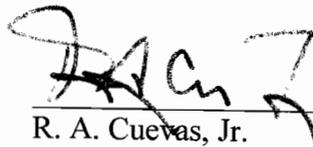

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY'S STATE  
CONTRACT LOBBYISTS ACCEPT A FIVE PERCENT  
REDUCTION IN REMAINING CONTRACT AMOUNTS

**WHEREAS**, the Board approved the County's Fiscal Year 2009-10 Budget on September 18, 2009 and the budget includes substantial cuts in many areas; and

**WHEREAS**, County contract lobbyists should also share in the cuts being made to other areas within the County budget,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board respectfully requests that the County's state contract lobbyists, including subcontractors and lobbyists hired under work orders, accept a five percent (5 %) reduction in the remaining contract amounts over the current contract term and any renewal terms.
