RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER TO PROVIDE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WITH A REPORT AT THE END OF JANUARY 2010 DETAILING THE PROPERTY APPRAISER'S PRELIMINARY ESTIMATES FOR THE 2010 TAX ROLL

WHEREAS, the budget preparation process for Miami-Dade County begins in January of each year with budget priorities being reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the County Manager is required, no later than January 31 of each year, to transmit to the Board of County Commissioners no more than twenty (20) of his or her top recommendations to be reflected in the coming year's budget; and

WHEREAS, those recommendations shall be considered by the appropriate committees of the County Commission, with each committee formulating its top priorities and policy objectives and forwarding its recommendations to the County Commission; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission shall no later than the first meeting of April of each year consider the committees' priorities and policy objectives and, by motion, approve up to twenty (20) priorities and policy objectives for the coming year's budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is in need of an estimate of the projected 2010 tax roll to assist in determining budgetary priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that any estimate from the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser at the end of January, 2010, would be somewhat speculative and subject to significant adjustments,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Miami-Dade County

Property Appraiser is requested to provide the Board of County Commissioners with a report at the end of January, 2010, detailing the Property Appraiser's preliminary estimates for the 2010 tax roll with respect to Miami-Dade County and the various municipalities.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


