

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING S.W. 112TH AVENUE
FROM CORAL WAY/S.W. 24TH STREET TO S.W. 32ND
STREET AS "PP EUSEBIO PEÑALVER BLVD"

WHEREAS, Eusebio Peñalver was born July 1, 1934 in the town of Ciego de Avila in the Cuban Province of Camaguey; and

WHEREAS, during the 1950s, Peñalver joined the 26th of July Movement, but shortly after Fidel Castro gained control of Cuba, Peñalver, then a young army officer, perceived the deceit of Castro, as Castro steered Cuba towards communism; and

WHEREAS, by the end of 1959, Peñalver was conspiring against the Castro regime as a counterrevolutionary and by the beginning of 1960 he was second-in-command of the First National Front of the Escambray, an armed uprising headed by Sinesio Walsh Rios; and

WHEREAS, on October 5th, 1960, Peñalver was captured with a large and important group of guerilla fighters, and subsequently condemned to 30 years in prison; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver went on to spend more than 28 years in prison and was one of the longest serving political prisoners; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver was a Plantado, a term used to describe those political prisoner who refuse to do forced labor and ideological indoctrination and does not cooperate with his captors; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver was released in October, 1988, and came to the U.S. where he dedicated the rest of his life to fighting Castro's tyranny; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver went on to lead the “Plantados until Freedom and Democracy in Cuba,” a group of former Cuban political prisoners in exile that Castro once accused of plotting to assassinate the president of Venezuela; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver passed away in May, 2006 at the age of 71 in Miami; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver has been aptly described as a Cuban Patriot and was believed to be one of the world’s oldest and longest-standing Black political prisoners of conscience, imprisoned for advocating free speech, free press, and free elections; and

WHEREAS, Peñalver was loved and admired by the Cuban-American community for his dedication and courage in the fight for Cuba’s liberty, and his presence will be sorely missed; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Eusebio Peñalver by codesignating S.W. 112th Avenue from Coral Way/S.W. 24th Street to S.W. 32nd Street as “PP Eusebio Peñalver Blvd”; and

WHEREAS, S.W. 112th Avenue from Coral Way/S.W. 24th Street to S.W. 32nd Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having conducted a public hearing, codesignates S.W. 112th Avenue from Coral Way/S.W. 24th Street to S.W. 32nd Street as “PP Eusebio Peñalver Blvd”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the

Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Sen. Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
