Subject: Resolution Releasing Canal Reservations in Miami-Dade County

Agenda Item No. 8(D)(1)(G)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the attached resolution releasing canal reservations in Sections 21 & 28, Township 52 South, Range 39 East in Miami-Dade County.

Scope

The subject item is limited to a parcel of land privately owned and is located in Commission District 12.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The subject item has no fiscal implications to Miami-Dade County. This item does not require the expenditure of any Miami-Dade County funds.

Track Record/Monitor

N/A

Background

The subject canal reservations were given to Miami-Dade County by the Central and Southern Florida Flood Control District, later known as the South Florida Water Management District, to be used for water management and flood protection in connection with the Miami-Dade County Water Control Master Plan. By virtue of Deed No. 68 recorded in Official Record Book 2916 at Page 674, and Deed No. 69 recorded in Official Record Book 2960 at Page 680, Miami-Dade County acquired rights in reservation through and across Sections 21 & 28, Township 52 South, Range 39 East.

The Water Control Plan shows no proposed canals in the referenced sections. The existing Tower Canal, which runs through Sections 21 & 28, is a ditch that is not incorporated in the Water Control Master Plan since the subject sections have been zoned for rockmining operations. Therefore, the aforesaid reservations are not needed for canal purposes.

Cemex Construction Materials of Florida owns the land in the referenced sections encumbered by those reservations and has requested the release of such interests which are no longer needed by Miami-Dade County.

The Department of Environmental Resources Management has reviewed this request and recommends the release of said rights in reservation.

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid canal reservations are no longer needed by Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby releases canal reservations in Sections 21 & 28, Township 52 South, Range 39 East, in Miami-Dade County, Florida, and authorizes execution of a disclaimer of canal reservations and recording of said disclaimer in the public records of Miami-Dade County in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, and pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, hereby directs the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to provide a recorded copy of the aforementioned disclaimer to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of the disclaimer by the Mayor or the Mayor's designee and furthermore directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy of the aforementioned disclaimer together with this Resolution.


The Chairperson thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this





