Subject: Resolution Authorizing a Waiver of County Residency Requirement and Authorizing Acceptance of the County Manager's Recommendation for Appointment to the Miami-Dade Climate Change Advisory Task Force for Carolyn Dekle

At the November 3, 2009 meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the Board approved eight (8) of the nine (9) County Manager's recommended appointments to the Miami-Dade Climate Change Advisory Task Force. Ms. Dekle was not approved because a waiver is required of the county residency requirement in Section 2-11.38 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution authorizing a waiver of the Miami-Dade County residency requirement and accepting the County Manager's recommendation for appointment to the Climate Change Advisory Task Force (CCATF) for Ms. Carolyn Dekle, Executive Director of the South Florida Regional Planning Council.

Scope

The recommendation is countywide in nature. The responsibility of the CCATF is to provide technical assistance and advice to the Board regarding climate change mitigation and adaptation measures.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This Resolution has no fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County.

Track Record/Monitor

The Clerk of the Board monitors the appointments to County boards.

Background

In July 2006, the Board passed Ordinance No. 06-113 that established the CCATF, a diverse, multidisciplinary group of 25 representatives of various sectors of the community to provide climate change-related technical assistance and recommendations to the Board. Among the 25 members of the CCATF, nine (9) member seats are recommended by the County Manager for appointment by the Board. The County Manager is directed by Ordinance to recommend appointments from governmental agencies and educational institutions on the basis of technical expertise to assist the work of the CCATF.

One of the agencies targeted to assist the CCATF with regional and intergovernmental recommendations on climate change is the South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC). The SFRPC Executive Director, Ms. Carolyn Dekle, is not a Miami-Dade County resident, but has provided assistance to the Miami-Dade CCATF for three years as Chair of the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee and also serves on the Broward Climate Change Advisory Task Force.

Because Ms. Dekle provides critical regional perspective, it is recommended that the residency requirement be waived and her appointment to the CCATF be accepted.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE MIAMI-DADE CLIMATE CHANGE ADVISORY TASK FORCE FOR CAROLYN DEKLE

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby authorizes a waiver of Miami-Dade County residency requirement of Section 2-11.38 by a two-thirds vote and authorizes acceptance of the County Manager's recommendation for the appointment of Ms. Carolyn Dekle to the Miami-Dade Climate Change Advisory Task Force; and authorizes the appointment of Ms. Carolyn Dekle, Executive Director of the South Florida Regional Planning Council, to the Miami-Dade Climate Change Advisory Task Force for a term of three years in accordance with Ordinance No. 06-113 and Section 2.11 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Creation of Boards.
