RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE PERFORMANCE AND EFFICIENCY COMMISSION AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-874-09 TO ALLOW THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO APPOINT TWO MEMBERS TO SUCH COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) created the Performance and Efficiency Commission pursuant to Resolution No. R-874-09 on June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the subject resolution requires the Board to appoint two of its members to serve on the Performance and Efficiency Commission; and

WHEREAS, for ease of process, it would be appropriate for the Chair of the Board to make these appointments, inasmuch as the Chairperson appoints Commissioners to County Commission committees pursuant to the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and the County Commission Rules of Procedure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolution No. R-874-09 is amended to provide that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners, instead of the Board, shall appoint two County Commissioners to serve on the Miami-Dade County Performance and Efficiency Commission.
