RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 107<sup>th</sup> COURT FROM  
SW 112<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO SW 116<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS "HUGO  
DELGADO WAY"

**WHEREAS**, Hugo Delgado was born in Cuba and moved to the United States in 1964;  
and

**WHEREAS**, Delgado attended Coral Way Elementary School, Shenandoah Middle School, Miami Senior High and the University of Miami, where he received his Bachelor in Science in electrical engineering in 1983; and

**WHEREAS**, Delgado began his federal service at NASA's John F. Kennedy Space Center as a University of Miami engineering co-op student in 1979 in the Shuttle Program Office working on flight computers; and

**WHEREAS**, Delgado served as the chief engineer for Advanced Development and Shuttle Upgrades from September 1996 to May 2000; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1998, Delgado served in a one-year assignment at NASA Headquarters advising in the development of Shuttle Upgrades Program guidelines and policy for the Office of Space Flight. Before that, Delgado served as the chairman of the Operation and Maintenance Requirements and Specification (OMRS) Control Board responsible for reviewing and approving changes to shuttle operational requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, Hugo Delgado eventually rose to be NASA's top engineer and was the chief of the Electrical Division of the Engineering Directorate at Kennedy Space Center; and

**WHEREAS**, during his more than 26 years in the U.S. Manned Space Flight Program, Delgado received many awards and honors including a Superior Achievement Award for the

development, checkout and launch software used during the first flight of space shuttle Columbia and an Exceptional Service Medal for his leadership of the engineering team during the production, testing and maiden launch of space shuttle Endeavour; and

**WHEREAS**, Delgado died on July 9, 2009 at age 50; and

**WHEREAS**, he was married to Judith Delgado and had one son, Kevin; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor Hugo Delgado with this co-designation; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 107<sup>th</sup> Court from SW 112<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 116<sup>th</sup> Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 107<sup>th</sup> Court from SW 112<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 116<sup>th</sup> Street as “Hugo Delgado Way”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Katy Sorenson. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
