**Subject:** Village of Pinecrest Interlocal Agreement

Agenda Item No. 9(A)(1)

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution retroactively authorizing an Interlocal Agreement with the Village of Pinecrest to upgrade communications technology for the Village's 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP). Retroactive approval is necessary since it is anticipated that the interface will be installed the week of February 8, 2010 and training will commence shortly thereafter.

**Scope**

This item impacts the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue (MDFR) District and the Village of Pinecrest.

**Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The cost authorized in the attached agreement will be provided from the fire district operating budget. A one-time cash outlay of no more than \$25,000 will be incurred by MDFR for the dedicated workstations and related network equipment as well as for training of the Village PSAP Dispatchers. The Village of Pinecrest will be responsible for the monthly recurring cost of \$180 for the T-1 Communications line after the first year of implementation.

**Track Record/Monitor**

The Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department will monitor this item.

**Background**

Currently, public safety requests from the Village of Pinecrest are received and processed through the Village's 911 PSAP. Once the Village's PSAP Call Taker determines that MDFR units are required to respond to an incident, the Village Call Taker telephones MDFR via a dedicated landline. This manual intervention delays the request for fire rescue services and can result in the erroneous transmission of data.

Execution of the Interlocal Agreement would allow the Village to enter incident information directly into MDFR's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system through an electronic interface. This procedure will eliminate transmission delays and increases the reliability of data as all information will be entered directly into the MDFR's CAD by the Village PSAP Call Taker. This interface serves as a cost-effective interim solution, in lieu of direct CAD to CAD interface which is currently estimated to cost \$150,000 to both the Village and County in the future. The entering into this agreement in no way obligates the Village or the County to any further enhancements or upgrades that may become available in the future.

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement between the Village of Pinecrest and Miami-Dade County to allow for an interface between MDFR's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system and the Village's 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) and authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute the agreement and to exercise any cancellation rights contained therein.





**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE  
OF PINECREST AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY**

THIS Agreement is entered into this 24<sup>th</sup> day of NOVEMBER, 2009, by and between the Village of Pinecrest (Village), a municipal corporation of the State of Florida and Miami-Dade County (the "County") a political subdivision of the State of Florida.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Pinecrest is an integral part of the Miami-Dade Fire District and

**WHEREAS**, the integration of the Village's Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) with Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department's (MDFR) Fire Communication is of utmost importance in reducing the time required to request fire suppression and rescue services in the Village of Pinecrest, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village and the County desire to enter into this Agreement to memorialize the agreement between the two entities in regard to the County providing upgraded communications technology for the Village's 911 PSAP,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Village and MDFR agree to the following:

1. The County will provide the following at no cost to the Village:
  - a) Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) System workstation comprised of two (2) Personal Computers, \$500 each and two (2) software licenses \$7,500 each (both are one-time cash outlays).
  - b) T-1 Communications Line (Installation, \$0, monthly recurring cost, \$180 – Total Annual Cost - \$2,160)
  - c) Required Network equipment comprised of one switch and router, \$1,200, one-time cash outlay.
  - d) Training of all Village PSAP Dispatchers holding the respective title will be based on mutually agreed to training schedule developed after execution of this Agreement.
2. MDFR will also be responsible for system support, license upgrades and standard maintenance and repair of equipment.
3. The Village will be responsible for the monthly recurring charge for the T-1 line after the full first year of operation (estimated monthly recurring cost, \$180 – Total Annual Cost - \$2,160). The Village will also bear the replacement cost for new equipment described in 1(a) above, as necessary.
4. This Agreement constitutes an interim solution which should be replaced by the direct CAD to CAD interface should the Village desire to pursue this option. As of the date of the execution of this Agreement, Direct CAD to CAD interface is


estimated to cost \$150,000 to both the Village and County. The entering into this agreement in no way obligates the Village to any further enhancements or upgrades that may become available in the future.

5. The provisions of this Agreement shall be in full force and effect commencing on the date of the execution of this Agreement and continuing for three years, with an option to renew for three additional one year terms, or until terminated by either entity upon a 90-day written notice.
6. Wherever possible, each provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted in such a manner as to be effective and valid under applicable law, but if any provision of this Agreement is prohibited or invalid under applicable law, the remaining provision of this Agreement shall not be affected by such invalidity.
7. Except as otherwise provided herein, any and all existing Agreements between the Village and MDFR shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be altered, changed, modified, amended, or terminated as a result of this Agreement.


