



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT FOR THE FEBRUARY 27, 2010 “RELAY FOR LIFE OF MIAMI SPRINGS” SPONSORED BY AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY , INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,978.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 6 FY 2008-09 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

Gentlemen:

You and your exempt subordinate units are not liable for the taxes imposed under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) unless waiver of exemption certificates are, or have been, filed as provided in such Act. 

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization, American Cancer Society, Inc., for their "Relay for Life of Miami Springs" event held on February 27, 2010.
