## RECOMMENDATION

This recommendation to award construction Contract No. S-838R to Lanzo Lining Services, Inc., in the amount of \$2,300,000, has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and is recommended for approval pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code, Section 2-8.1. WASD is required to make repairs to the sewage collection system to comply with the Volume Sewer Customer Ordinance, and the Wellfield Protection Ordinance, Section 24-13.1 and Section 24-12.1 of the Miami-Dade County Code, respectively.

## DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County.

## SCOPE

**PROJECT NAME:** One Year Countywide Contract for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Cured-in-Place Pipe Lining Method with County Option to Renew for an Additional Three Years on a Yearly Basis

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The project consists of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to repair approximately 46,000 linear feet of 8-inch through 24 inch diameter gravity sanitary sewer pipe under different work orders by the cured-in-place pipe lining method at different locations anywhere within the limits of Miami Dade County, Florida, as ordered by WASD during a one year period. This is a non-exclusive contract, and as such, WASD may issue similar contracts for this type of work, and therefore, does not guarantee that the full amount of the contract work listed in the proposal will be issued to the contractor. The amount of work orders assigned is at WASD's sole discretion and is dependent only upon its needs.

The work will also include the following: restoration of approximately 550 service laterals, including sealing the lateral connections; cleaning and video inspections; supplementary cleaning of the sewers to be repaired, removal and proper disposal of solids as required; bypass pumping of sewage; maintenance of traffic (MOT); and all other appurtenant and

miscellaneous items and work for a completed project.

The unit prices bid will be used for uniform comparison amongst the bidders and the bids will be evaluated based upon the lowest bid dollar amount. The contract will be awarded for an aggregate amount up to \$2,300,000 for a 12-month period. The contract will terminate upon the depletion of the \$2,300,000 or the expiration of the 12-month period.

The Board of County Commissioners has the option to renew the contract for an additional three years, for a total amount of \$6,900,000, with the same unit prices used in the original contract. Each renewable option is for a one year period and \$2,300,000.

It is WASD's intent to obtain a completely functional and satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.

Should such evidence not be satisfactory to the Engineer, whose decision shall be final, the bid will be considered non-responsive, and the second low bidder shall be considered for award. The qualifying proof shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope at time of bidding.

**EXPLANATION:** WASD received five (5) bids for this project, all of which were under the Engineer's estimate. There was less than an 8.7% difference between the base bids of the three lowest bidders, showing good competition. WASD's recommendation is to award this contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Lanzo Lining Services, Inc., whose base bid is 29.8% under the Engineer's base estimate.

In October 2009, Lanzo Lining Services, Inc. was awarded 1 project, RPQ P0042, via OCI's CICC 7360-0/08 MCC blanket. The Office of Capital Improvements CIIS database contains an interim evaluation for Lanzo Lining Services, Inc. of 4.0 out of a possible 4.0, indicating superior performance.

If after the first year the Department is satisfied with the contractor's work, the Board of County Commissioners has the option to renew the contract for up to an additional three years, with the same unit prices used in the original contract, with an additional total amount of \$6,900,000. Each renewal option will be for a one year period, and \$2,300,000.

## CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Miami-Dade County, Florida, party of the first part (hereinafter sometimes called the "County"), and **Lanzo Lining Services, Inc.**, party of the second part (hereinafter sometimes called "Contractor");

### WITNESSETH

That the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, mutually agree as follows, to wit:

1. That the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and equipment and perform all work in the manner and form provided by the Contract Documents covering the Project of the County known and identified as

**"One-Year Countywide Contract for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Cured-In-Place Pipe Lining Method with County Option to Renew for an Additional Three Years on a Yearly Basis, Contract No. S-838R"**

for the aggregate amount reflected by the Proposal, said aggregate amount being of **Two Million Three Hundred Dollars and No Cents (U.S. Dollars) \$2,300,000.00**. The Contract will be awarded for an aggregate amount of up to \$2,300,000 for a one-year period. Unless the Contract is renewed, it will terminate upon the depletion of the awarded amount or the expiration of the one-year period, whichever occurs first. The one-year term of the Contract will commence with the Issuance of the Notice to Proceed. The Board of County Commissioners has the option to renew the Contract for up to an additional three years on a year to year basis, provided that the Contractor maintains the prices, etc. used in the original contract, with an additional total amount of up to \$6,900,000. Each renewal option will be for a one-year period and up to \$2,300,000. The County does not guarantee that the full amount of the Contract will be issued to the Contractor. Continuation of the Contract beyond the initial period is a County prerogative not a right of the bidder. This prerogative will be exercised only when such continuation is clearly in the best interest of the County. The actual amount of work orders assigned is also a prerogative of the County in its sole discretion and dependent only upon its needs.

2. That the Contractor shall begin the work to be performed under this Contract on a day to be specified in a written order issued by the Engineer, and shall fully complete all work hereunder within the time or times stated in the Proposal.

3. That the County shall pay to the Contractor for the faithful performance of this Contract, in lawful money of the United States, and subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents, the total amount of his proposal as set forth above at the times and in a manner stated in the General Covenants and Conditions of the Contract Documents.

4. It is further mutually agreed that if at any time after the execution of this Contract, Surety Performance and Payment Bond, the County shall deem the surety upon such bonds to be unsatisfactory, or if for any reason such bond shall become inadequate to cover the performance of the work, the Contractor shall at his own expense, within five (5) days after the receipt of notice from the County to do so, furnish an additional bond or bonds in such form and amount and with such surety or sureties as shall be satisfactory to the County. In such event, no further payment to the Contractor shall be deemed to be due under this Contract until such new or additional security shall have been furnished in a manner and form satisfactory to the County.

5. The "Contract Documents" are hereby defined as the Questionnaire, the Advertisement for Bids, the Instructions to Bidders, the Proposal, the Certified Resolution (Proposal/Prescribed Bid Bond), the Prescribed Bid Bond, the Contract, the Surety Performance and Payment Bond, the Certified Resolution (Contract/ Surety Performance and Payment Bond), the General Covenants and Conditions, the Supplemental General Conditions (if Ordinance 90-143 is applicable) including Wage and Benefit Schedules, the Specifications, the Plans, any
