

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO THE
CITY OF MIAMI AND THE VILLAGE OF KEY BISCAZYNE
REGARDING UPCOMING EVENTS WHICH IMPACT
RICKENBACKER CAUSEWAY

WHEREAS, the Rickenbacker Causeway is a scenic roadway connecting the City of Miami, Florida, to the barrier islands of Virginia Key and Key Biscayne across Biscayne Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Rickenbacker Causeway is heavily used by automobile, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic; and

WHEREAS, certain large events sponsored by the County, or at County facilities, can alter traffic flow or temporarily increase pedestrian and vehicular traffic along Rickenbacker Causeway, including areas within the City of Miami and the Village of Key Biscayne; and

WHEREAS, both the City of Miami and the Village of Key Biscayne may wish to take actions they deem appropriate, to implement measures responsive to such changes in traffic flow which may occur during such events; and

WHEREAS, notification by the County prior to such events would help to provide the City of Miami and the Village of Key Biscayne with adequate time to implement any such measures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee is hereby directed to provide notice to the appropriate officials at the City of Miami and the Village of Key Biscayne prior to events sponsored by the County, or held at

County facilities, which would impact pedestrian and vehicular flow along the Rickenbacker Causeway.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
