

RESOLUTION REGARDING A CONFLICT WAIVER  
REQUEST BY RONALD L. BOOK, P.A. PURSUANT TO ITS  
STATE LOBBYING CONTRACT WITH MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, on January 21, 2010, the Board approved Resolution No. 56-10, which requires all contract lobbyist conflict of interest waiver requests to be submitted to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, who shall place the conflict waiver request on the next available Board of County Commissioners agenda; and

**WHEREAS**, the law firm of Ronald L. Book, P.A. is a member of Miami-Dade County's (the "County") state lobbying team; and

**WHEREAS**, Ronald L. Book submitted the attached letter seeking the County's consent to its representation of Surety Bond/Bail Bond Industry related to SB 782 and HB 445 filed for consideration during the 2010 state legislative session; and

**WHEREAS**, the lobbying contract between Ronald L. Book, P.A. and the County provides that the Board may take, in its sole discretion, any action regarding a waiver of request, including but not limited to the following:

1. Grant a waiver and allow Ronald L. Book, P.A. to represent both the County and the other party;
2. Refuse to grant a waiver and void its contract with the Ronald L. Book, P.A.; and
3. Grant a limited waiver, allow the firm to continue to represent both the County and the other party under whatever limitations or restrictions the County in its sole discretion determines to be appropriate,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board grants a limited waiver to Ronald L. Book, P.A. pursuant to its state lobbying contract with the County,

prohibiting Ronald L. Book, P.A. from taking any action or position for or against SB 782, HB 445 or similar legislation related to pretrial release, but allowing the firm to continue to represent both the County and Surety Bond/Bail Bond Industry on other matters not in conflict.



Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter is written with regard to SB 782 and HB 445, related to the Surety Bond/Bail Bond industry. As you are aware, my firm has represented the Bail industry for over fifteen years. In fact, we have represented the Bail industry for a longer period of time than we have represented the County.

It has come to my attention that there may be some opposition to this Bill by local governments, and I am, therefore, putting you on notice of a potential conflict. That said, I believe this legislation is not only good public policy, but I believe it will likely be supported by many local government officials who want to make certain that their communities are safer, and there is some level of accountability and checks and balances from those who run and operate the County's Pretrial Release Program. I find it of great interest that the National Association of Pretrial Release officials have made it a point of trying to do away with the Bail industry, in order to allow them to increase their bureaucratic operations at the taxpayer's expense. I am seeking a Waiver to allow me to continue my representation of the Bail industry.

I look forward to discussing this further with you and/or the Commission at the appropriate time.
