

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SEEK ASSISTANCE FROM THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OFFICE OF THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS, AND TO APPLY, RECEIVE AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION, CENTER FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TOTALING UP TO \$750,000 PER YEAR FOR UP TO FIVE (5) YEARS, AND TO EXECUTE SUCH CONTRACTS, AGREEMENTS AND MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING AND AMENDMENTS AFTER APPROVAL BY THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, RECEIVE AND EXPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS THAT MAY BECOME AVAILABLE

WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMHSA"), Center for Mental Health Services ("CMHS") seeks to foster adoption and implementation of transformative changes in how public mental health services are organized, managed, and delivered; and

WHEREAS, SAMHSA has identified five (5) strategic initiatives related to: (i) prevention and wellness, (ii) trauma-informed care, (iii) military families, (iv) housing and homelessness and/or (v) jobs and the economy; and

WHEREAS, SAMHSA is providing funding to support local governments in creating and/or expanding treatment capacity within those strategic initiatives; and

WHEREAS, CMHS administers SAMHSA's fiscal year 2010 Mental Health Transformation Grants program ("MHTG") intending to support and promote best practices, consumer-driven, recovery-oriented, and evidence-based behavioral health care related to the SAMHSA strategic initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2010 funding for MHTG focuses on services for adults with, or at-risk for, serious mental illnesses; and

WHEREAS, CMHS and Miami-Dade County recognize that continued improvement in the delivery and financing of prevention, treatment and recovery support services provides a cost effective opportunity to improve and protect the public's mental health; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to promote public mental health for Miami-Dade County resident adults by creating or expanding treatment capacity within SAMHSA's five (5) strategic initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County local office of the State of Florida Department of Children and Families has the skill and experience to assist Miami-Dade County in its fiscal year 2010 MHTG program grant application; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2010 MHTG grant application deadline is April 30, 2010,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to seek assistance from the Miami-Dade County office of the Florida Department of Children and Families to apply for Mental Health Transformation Grants program grant funds and to apply, receive and expend grant funds from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for Mental Health Services totaling up to \$750,000 per year for up to five (5) years; and directing the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to execute such contracts, agreements, Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) and amendments after approval by the County Attorney's Office as to form and legal sufficiency, as required by program guidelines. It is also recommended that the Board authorize the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to apply for, receive and expend additional funds that may become available during the term of the grant; to file and execute any amendments to the application for and on behalf of the

County, and to exercise amendments, modifications, renewal, cancellation and termination clauses of any contracts and agreements, subject to approval by the County Attorney's Office as to form and legal sufficiency on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


