RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING BIRD ROAD FROM SW
117 AVENUE TO SW 127 AVENUE AS "FATHER JOSE
GARCIA 'PEPITO' STREET"

WHEREAS, Father Jose Garcia was born in Holguin, Cuba, and from an early age wanted to become a priest; and

WHEREAS, Father Garcia studied for priesthood at El Cobre Seminary in Santiago and served as a priest in Puerto Padre and in Camaguey, Cuba; and

WHEREAS, upon his arrival in Miami in 1987, Father Garcia was assigned to St. Kevin Catholic Church where he has remained for over 23 years; and

WHEREAS, Father Pepito, as the parishioners call him, has been instrumental in helping couples prepare for marriage, and since the church is close to a hospital, he has also spent a large part of his time comforting the sick and their families; and

WHEREAS, Father Garcia will celebrate his Golden Anniversary reflecting 50 years as a priest on May 5, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Bird Road from SW 117 Avenue to SW 127 Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Father Jose Garcia 'Pepito' with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, finds that Father Jose Garcia has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community.

Section 2. By a three-fifths vote of the Board members present, co-designates Bird Road from SW 117 Avenue to SW 127 Avenue as “Father Jose Garcia ‘Pepito’ Street”.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Sen. Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
