RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW  
77 AVENUE FROM SW 136 STREET TO SW 138 TERRACE  
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY AS  
“HURRICANE HIGHWAY”

**WHEREAS**, Howard Drive Elementary School is located within the Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, and is an A rated school; and

**WHEREAS**, Howard Drive Elementary School continues to strive for excellence under the outstanding direction, commitment and dedication of its Principal, Deanna Dalby, teachers, staff, and student body; and

**WHEREAS**, Howard Drive Elementary School deserves recognition and thanks for its dedication to maintaining high quality standards of education in Miami-Dade County and responding to the growing needs of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of this outstanding school, the Village of Palmetto Bay has passed Resolution No. 2010-46, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, requesting Miami-Dade County to co-designate that portion of SW 77 Avenue that fronts the eastern boundary of the school from SW 136 Street south to SW 138 Terrace; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of the outstanding achievements of Howard Drive Elementary School, Miami-Dade County would like to honor the school by co-designating SW 77 Avenue from SW 136 Street south to SW 138 Terrace as “Hurricane Highway”, in honor of the school’s mascot; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed co-designation is a county road located in the Village of Palmetto Bay in County Commission District 8,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having conducted a public hearing, co-designates that portion of SW 77 Avenue from SW 136 Street to SW 138 Terrace within the Village of Palmetto Bay as “Hurricane Highway”.

**Section 2.** The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and Village Council of the Village of Palmetto Bay, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CO-DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF SW 77 AVENUE THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, ESSENTIALLY FROM SW 136 STREET TO SW 138 TERRACE AS "HURRICANE HIGHWAY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
