JUNE 23 THEREAFTER AS OLYMPIC DAY IN MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY

WHEREAS, Olympic Day is celebrated annually on June 23 to commemorate the birth of the modern Olympic Games; and

WHEREAS, Olympic Day is not only a celebration, but an international effort to promote fitness and well-being in addition to the Olympic ideals of fair play, perseverance, respect and sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS, the goal of Olympic Day is to promote Olympic values and participation in sport across the globe regardless of age, gender or athletic ability; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to recognize June 23, 2010 and each June 23 thereafter as Olympic Day in Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Declares June 23, 2010 and each June 23 thereafter as Olympic Day in Miami-Dade County.

Section 2. Encourages the Miami-Dade Sports Commission to develop and arrange for appropriate events, programs and activities to commemorate Olympic Day in Miami-Dade County, and respectfully requests that the Sports Commission work with the prime sponsor of this item in doing so.
