Summary

This resolution rescinds Resolution 200-10 that authorized the execution of amendments to the Lease Agreement and the Concession and License Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Miami Parking Authority.

Background and Relevant Information

On February 18, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners, through Resolution 200-10, amended a Lease Agreement and the Concession and License Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Miami Parking Authority, for Lot 18, Folio No. 01-3135-037-0020; Lot 26, Folio No. 01-3135-037-0080; and Lot 27, Folio No. 01-3135-037-0010 to accommodate temporary use of an open-air flea market during weekend hours and legal holidays.

The lots are located at the Richard E. Gerstein Criminal Courthouse (Civic Center area). In addition to the courthouse, the Civic Center area includes jails, hospitals, the Miami-Dade Public Defender's Office and the State Attorney's Office.

Amendment Highlights

The Miami Parking Authority would have paid rent to Miami-Dade County in the amount of 50 percent of the total gross revenue received from the flea market and any parking income received during such operation.

The following questions were posed to General Administration Services (GSA) staff:

- By how much would the rental income increase? What is the rental income now?
The County is paid approximately \$75,000 per annum Monday to Friday for operations on each lot. The proposed dollars would be in addition to the \$75,000 since the lots are not currently used on weekends.
