Recommendation

The following plat is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval and recording of the plat listed below. This plat is bounded on the north by approximately SW 10 Street, on the east by SW 3 Avenue, on the south by approximately SW 12 Street, and on the west by I-95.

Background

MIAMI HEIGHTS SEWER PUMP STATION (T-23074)

- Located in Section 38, Township 54 South, Range 41 East
- Commission District: 5
- Zoning: R-4
- Proposed Usage: Sewer pump station
- Number of parcels: 1
- This plat meets concurrency
- Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department's Sewer Pump Station No. 8 needs to be relocated from its present location in the middle of Brickell Avenue between SE 11 Street and SE 12 Street to a new location at SW 3 Avenue near I-95 and SW 11 Street (new underground structures for sewer suction and pump vaults with its own aboveground structures for mechanical, electrical and generator rooms). This new location includes a portion of SW 11 Street vacated by City of Miami resolution, which requires the land to be re-platted. A re-plat for the new location of the pump station site is also necessary because of the modification that will be made of the configuration to the original platted lots, adjacent and included with said vacated portion of right-of-way. In doing so, the plat law states that it must be re-platted whenever lots are to be modified.


Plat Restrictions

- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.
- That the use of septic tanks will not be permitted within this subdivision, unless approved for temporary use, in accordance with County and State regulations.
- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.
- That the limited access right-of-way lines, as illustrated on the plat, are hereby designated for the express purpose of preventing direct vehicular access to and from the adjoining road.
- That the utility easements, depicted by dashed lines on the plat, are hereby reserved for the installation and maintenance of public utilities.

Developer's Obligation

- All required improvements will be bonded with the City of Miami.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE PLAT OF MIAMI HEIGHTS SEWER PUMP STATION, ON BEHALF OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY, AS FEE SIMPLE TITLE HOLDER, LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 38, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY APPROXIMATELY SW 10 STREET, ON THE EAST BY SW 3 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY APPROXIMATELY SW 12 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY I-95)

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as MIAMI HEIGHTS SEWER PUMP STATION, the same being a replat of a portion of Lots 1 and 2, Block 83s of "Miami Heights", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 5, at Page 29, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and a portion of Lots 19 and 20, Block 77s of "Map of Miami", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book B, at Page 41, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and that portion of SW 11 Street vacated by City of Miami Resolution R-06-0194, all lying and being in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 38, Township 54 South, Range 41 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the plat of Miami Heights Sewer Pump Station on behalf of Miami-Dade County in its capacity as fee simple title holder.


