Subject: Resolution Designating a Portion of Miami-Dade County Owned Property Known as South Dade Park as Road Right-of-Way; Located in Section 5, Township 57 South, Range 39 East Commission District 8

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution designating a portion of Miami-Dade County-owned property known as South Dade Park as road Right-of-Way for SW 280 Street and the radius returns located at the intersections of SW 164 Avenue with SW 280 Street; SW 164 Avenue with SW 282 Street; SW 163 Avenue with SW 280 Street; and SW 163 Avenue with SW 282 Street, located in Section 5, Township 57 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Scope

The subject property is located within Commission District 8.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact associated with this right of way dedication.

Costs associated with relocation of an existing fence and sidewalk encroaching on the right of way are estimated at \$55,000 and will be funded from Park Improvement Impact Fees. This portion of the project is currently budgeted and will have a one-time impact with no recurring operation and maintenance costs.

The estimated cost for the future park improvements (which at this time are not scheduled to go into construction until approximately 2015 or beyond) are \$5 million and will be funded out of future Building Better Communities –General Obligation Bond funds. Additional operation & maintenance costs upon project build out are anticipated to be negligible as the improvements consist mainly of the replacement of an existing pool; all other improvements are pending the identification of operating funds.

Track Record/Monitor

Not Applicable.

Background

The subject property, South Dade Park, was acquired by the Park and Recreation Department (PRD). PRD has requested that all those portions of the subject property lying within the zoned right-of-way be designated road right-of-way.

These road dedications will improve vehicular traffic safety in this area of Miami-Dade County. Planned immediate improvements include relocation of a fence and portions of a concrete sidewalk encroaching on the right of way; future park improvements include aquatic facility improvements, specifically the replacement of the competition pool with accessible area, expansion of bathhouse building, expansion of parking, and park irrigation.

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The subject property is County owned property under the jurisdiction of PRD. All properties being developed are required by County Code to dedicate the zoned right-of-way and the radius returns. Therefore, as required by County Code, the zoned right-of-way and the radius returns of PRD's property need to be dedicated.

The Directors of the Park and Recreation Department and Public Works Department agree upon the public benefits to be derived from the designation of portions of this parcel for road right-of-way purposes.

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY KNOWN AS SOUTH DADE PARK AS ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR SW 280 STREET AND THE RADIUS RETURNS LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF SW 164 AVENUE WITH SW 280 STREET; SW 164 AVENUE WITH SW 282 STREET; SW 163 AVENUE WITH SW 280 STREET; AND SW 163 AVENUE WITH SW 282 STREET, IN SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 57 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST

Legal Description

All that portion of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 57 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida more particularly described as follows:

The South 5 feet of the North 40 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4

And

That area bounded by the West line of East 25 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the South line of the North 40 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, and bounded by a 25 foot radius arc concave to the southwest and tangent to both of the last described lines.

And


That area bounded by North line of the South 25 feet of NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the West line of the East 25 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and bounded by a 25 foot radius arc concave to the northwest and tangent to both of the last described lines.

And

That area bounded by the North line of the South 25 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the East line of the West 25 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and bounded by a 25 foot radius arc concave to the northeast and tangent to both of the last described lines.

And

That area bounded by the South line of the North 40 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the East line of the West 25 feet of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and bounded by a 25 foot radius arc concave to the southeast and tangent to both of the last described lines.
