Subject: Resolution Accepting a Deed in Donation of Approximately 31.45 Acres of Real Property within the South Dade Wetlands Acquisition Project from Jack B. Levy, Ruth Campbell and Shirley Ghezzi, Trustees, to the Miami-Dade County Environmentally Endangered Lands Program

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution accepting a deed in donation of approximately 31.45 acres of wetlands (see Attachment A) to the Miami-Dade County Environmentally Endangered Lands (EEL) Program. The resolution also authorizes the expenditure of up to \$90,000 in transaction costs and thanks Trustees Jack B. Levy, Ruth Campbell and Shirley Ghezzi for their generous donation and transfer of the deed (see Attachment B) of real property with a 2009 tax assessed value of \$1,258,000. The subject property lies within the Keyhole Wetlands Addition to the South Dade Wetlands EEL Acquisition Project which was placed on the EEL Priority A Acquisition List by Resolution No. R-102-10, as approved by the Board on February 2, 2010.

Scope

The EEL Program is countywide in nature. This acquisition is located in Commission District 9. The County Commission placed the South Dade Wetlands Project on the EEL Priority A Acquisition List in 1993 and the Keyhole Wetlands Addition to the South Dade Wetlands Project on the EEL Priority A Acquisition List in 2010. To date, the County, in partnership with the South Florida Water Management District, the State of Florida, and other funding partners, has acquired approximately 21,097 acres of land throughout Miami-Dade County since inception of the EEL Program.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This action will reduce the EEL Acquisition Trust Fund by an amount up to \$90,000 but would have a positive fiscal impact by avoiding the cost of purchasing land that has a 2009 tax assessed value of \$1,258,000. As of May 31, 2010, the balance of the EEL Trust Fund (Subfund 081, Project Numbers 081005/-6/-7/-8) is \$58,940,189, of which \$26,549,596 is reserved for acquisition and \$32,390,593 is reserved for management.

Track Record/Monitor

Not Applicable.

Background

The Keyhole Wetlands were added to the South Dade Wetlands Project on the EEL Priority A Acquisition List in 2010. The natural areas consist of seasonally flooded freshwater and marl prairie wetlands, including sawgrass, native shrubs and some exotic species. There are over 100 plant species that have been identified within the Keyhole Wetlands, including two listed by the State of Florida as endangered. Over 85% of the identified vegetative species are native. The South Dade Wetlands Project area contains an important wetland system in the southern part of the County and this area is targeted for acquisition because of its strategic location between two national parks (Everglades National Park and Biscayne National Park) within the watersheds of Florida Bay, Biscayne Bay, Card Sound and Barnes Sound. Preserving and maintaining these wetlands is important for protecting against saltwater intrusion of the Biscayne Aquifer and because of the importance of the region to endangered and threatened species. Jack B. Levy, Ruth Campbell and Shirley Ghezzi, Trustees, are willing to donate their 31.45 acre parcel within the Keyhole Wetlands which is directly adjacent to EEL land within the South Dade Wetlands. The parcel is located at US-1 just south of SW 360 Street and has a 2009 Property Appraised value of \$1,258,000.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DEED IN DONATION OF APPROXIMATELY 31.45 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE SOUTH DADE WETLANDS ACQUISITION PROJECT FROM JACK B. LEVY, RUTH CAMPBELL AND SHIRLEY GHEZZI, TRUSTEES, TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ENVIRONMENTALLY ENDANGERED LANDS PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF TRANSACTION FEES NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000; AND THANKING TRUSTEES JACK B. LEVY, RUTH CAMPBELL AND SHIRLEY GHEZZI FOR SAID DONATION

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes of Section 24-50 of the Code of Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby authorizes acceptance of a deed in donation of approximately 31.45 acres of wetlands within the Keyhole Wetlands Addition to the South Dade Wetlands Project from Jack B. Levy, Ruth Campbell and Shirley Ghezzi, Trustees, to the Miami-Dade County Environmentally Endangered Lands Program in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof; authorizes the payment of transaction fees not to exceed \$90,000; extends thanks to Trustees Jack B. Levy, Ruth Campbell and Shirley Ghezzi for their generous donation of land; and pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, (a) direct the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to provide a recorded copy of any instrument prepared in accordance herewith to the Clerk of the Board within Thirty days of execution and final acceptance; and (b) direct the Clerk of the Board to

attach and permanently store a recorded copy of any instrument provided in accordance herewith together with the authorizing resolution.



WARRANTY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made ^{PEL} this 3rd day of June, 2010, between JACK B. LEVY, RUTH E. CAMPBELL and SHIRLEY GHEZZI, Individually and as Trustees under a certain Agreement dated December 10, 1974, whose post office address is 7915 SW 128th Street, Pinecrest, Florida, 33156, ("Grantors"), in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, received from MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Environmentally Endangered Lands Program (EEL), and its successors in interest, ("Grantee") whose post office address is ATTN: EEL PROGRAM, 701 NW First Court, 4th Floor, Miami, Florida 33136, of the County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold to the said Grantee, and Grantee's successors and assigns forever, the following described lands, situate, lying and being in Miami-Dade County, Florida, to-wit (the "Premises"):

TOGETHER with all the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

THIS CONVEYANCE includes, without limitation, all of the following rights owned by the Grantor(s), if any, all timber rights and water rights; all mineral rights and gas rights except those previously reserved, transferred or severed by third parties; all Grantors's rights, title and interest in roads, streams, canals, ditches and other water bodies located on the Premises or which may provide access to the Premises; all riparian rights; and all Grantors's rights, title and interest in alleys, roads, streets and easements included within the Premises, or which may provide access to the Premises.

SUBJECT TO: Easements, dedications and restrictions of record, if any, but any such interests that may have been terminated are not hereby reimposed and subject to applicable zoning ordinances, taxes and assessments for the year 2008 and subsequent years.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same in fee simple forever.

AND the Grantors hereby covenant with the Grantee that the Grantors are lawfully seized of said lands in fee simple; that the Grantors have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey said lands; that the Grantors hereby fully warrant the title to said lands and will defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and that said lands are free of all encumbrances.

GRANTORS warrant that the Premises or subject property is not the Constitutional Homestead of the Grantors, as the Grantors do not reside on the Premises or subject property or any property contiguous therewith as their permanent residence or homestead, but in fact the property is vacant land.






