**Subject:** Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$885,000.00 between AGC Electric, Inc. and Miami-Dade County for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Project Entitled School Speed-Zone Flashing Signals Contract – Countywide (**Project – MCC 7360 Plan Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20100428**) and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transit Surtax Funds

**Recommendation**

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the School Speed-Zone Flashing Signals Contract - Countywide (Project – MCC 7360 Plan RPQ No. 20100428), in the amount of \$885,000.00, between AGC Electric, Inc. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

**Scope**

The work to be performed under the life of this contract includes the installation of school speed-zone flashing signals at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

**Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$885,000.00 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the PTP School Flashing Signals Program. This is a work order based contract with a base contract amount of \$750,000.00. The total recommended award amount is \$885,000.00, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances. The estimated operation and maintenance (O&M) costs are \$500 annually for each School Flashing Signal installed and will be funded through the Department's General Funds.

**Delegation of Authority**

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this contract.

**Track Record/Monitor**

AGC Electric, Inc. is currently performing work for PWD at a satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager. PWD has reviewed the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) database and found nine (9) awarded construction contracts and are listed as follows: one (1) from the General Services Administration Department (GSA) and eight (8) from PWD. The referenced database also lists a total of seven (7) contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of satisfactory performance (3.7), out of a possible superior performance (4.0) rating.

The Department of Small Business Development's (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. Frank Aira, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. George Brown, Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, AGC Electric, Inc., Company Principals are: Tomas V. Curbelo, Enrique I. Guzman and Pierrette De La Sierra and the Company's address is listed as: 2660 West 79 Street, Hialeah, Florida 33016.


### **Background**

In an effort to carry on the success of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under OCI contract MCC 7360 Plan. Through this process, PWD forwards the Request for Proposal Quotation (RPQ), by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of firms that have registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. Interested contractors prepare their bids according to the Job Order Contracting (JOC) process, whereby the County establishes unit prices for the pay items in accordance with industry averages. The contractors submit their bid as an overall percentage factor of the pricing established by the County. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest percentage submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the SBD Review Committee. The Review Committee met on April 14, 2010 reviewed RPQ No. 20100428 and recommended a 10% overall CSBE subcontractor goal and an 11.2% Community Workforce Program (CWP) goal based on the project's scope of work and cost estimate of \$750,000.00. Therefore, on April 22, 2010, PWD forwarded an RPQ for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) School Speed-Zone Flashing Signals Contract - Countywide, utilizing the OCI contract MCC 7360 Plan, to a list of three (3) pre-registered firms. A total of 11 firms purchased contract documents and 9 firms proffered a bid.

On May 28, 2010, AGC Electric, Inc., proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of 0.59 percentage factor, 41% below the County's cost estimate; the second lowest bidder, Statewide Electrical Services, Inc., proffered a base bid of 0.70 percentage factor, 11% over the lowest bidder; the third lowest bidder, Florida Sol System, Inc., proffered a base bid of 0.75 percentage factor, 5% over the second lowest bidder. As a result, on June 28, 2010, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ No. 20100428 to AGC Electric, Inc., with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment and tools to perform all operations necessary for the installation of solar school speed-zone overhead flashing lights and midblock traffic signal consisting of mastarm combinations with solar powered flashing beacons and regulatory signs, and pedestals with solar powered flashing beacons and regulatory signs. Additional work also includes installation of pedestal mounted controller cabinets; conduit, pedestrian ramps, grounding rods, pulls boxes, ground mounted signs, and pavement markings.

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The Department of Small Business Development (SBD) has completed its review of the subject project for compliance with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program for Construction Services. The contract measure established for this project is a 10% CSBE subcontractor goal and an 11.2% Community Workforce Program (CWP) goal.

The Contracts & Specifications Section of the Public Works Department has submitted bid documents from AGC Electric, Corp. (#1), Statewide Electrical Services, Inc. (#2), and Florida Sol Systems, Inc. (#3) for compliance review. Following is the pre-award compliance status and summary.

## SUMMARY:

AGC Electric, Corp. (#1) submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavits committing to utilize Statewide Maintenance, Inc., a certified CSBE firm, to perform signs & striping work at 8%, Mega Electric, Inc., a certified CSBE firm, to perform wiring-test work at 2% and Atlas Pavement & Concrete, Inc. , a certified CSBE firm, to provide concrete work at 2%. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. AGC Electric, Corp., has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

Statewide Electrical Services, Inc. (#2), a certified CSBE firm, submitted the required SOI Affidavit committing to perform traffic signal electrical work with its own forces at 5%. A B C Construction, Inc., a CSBE certified firm, was also listed on an SOI to perform concrete work at 5%. A B C Construction, Inc. signed the SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Statewide Electrical Services, Inc. has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

Florida Sol Systems, Inc. (#3), a certified CSBE firm, submitted the required SOI Affidavit committing to perform electrical work with its own forces at 95%. An SOI affidavit was also submitted which listed Quality Paving, Corp., a certified CSBE firm, to perform concrete work at 5%. Quality Paving, Corp. signed the SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Florida Sol Systems, Inc. has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.




