

RESOLUTION DECLARING ONE 2001 DODGE CARGO VAN  
SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS DONATION TO FOOD  
OF LIFE OUTREACH MINISTRIES INC.

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle described below is owned by Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle is obsolete, and its continued usage by Miami-Dade County is uneconomical and inefficient and the vehicle serves no useful purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Food of Life Outreach Ministries Inc., (the "Donee") desires to use the vehicle only within Miami-Dade County to enhance its ability to provide services to its constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Donee is a private not-for-profit organization as defined in Section 273.01 (3) of the Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Federal Income Taxation by virtue of Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Donee is an eligible community-based organization, as defined in Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County General Services Administration has complied with the requirements of Section 2-11.2.1, by offering the vehicle to other Miami-Dade County Agencies, none of which accepted the vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle is eligible for donation under Section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

Section 1. This Board declares the following vehicle, with the listed residual value and other characteristics, to be surplus pursuant to Section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County:

Section 2. This Board authorizes donation of the vehicle to the Donee. The Donee shall take possession of the vehicle within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution and shall be responsible for any and all costs of transferring the vehicle. The County Manager shall and is hereby directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. If, for any reason, the donee fails to take possession of the vehicle within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the vehicle shall revert back to the County.



Mr. Bannerman, as per your request, this letter is sent to address the pertinent needs of Food of Life Outreach Ministries Inc... As you now know through our previous discussion, that we are a Feeding South Florida Agent as well as a new USDA food distribution agency. This new status brings more food to distribute but also brings more expenses and operating costs, as well as the need for new and more equipment.

The equipment needs are as follows: 1 vehicle (Cargo Van) 2 freezers (5.0 to 7.2cubit ft.) (13 to 24.9 cubit ft.) 1 hand truck.

Our next needs issue, centers around storage space. We are scheduled to receive our first USDA food allotment in approximately two weeks. This allotment is intended to feed one hundred sixty persons per week and will arrive on a weekly basis there after. We must add storage space immediately that is climate controlled. We are asking for three thousand dollars to lease this space which is located next door to our existing office and storage space located at 701 S. Homestead Blvd./U.S. 1 suite 3 Homestead FL.33030. In addition to the money requested for the lease, we also request five hundred dollars for new advertising and printing cost to alert the citizens of South Miami Dade County of the availability of free supplemental foods. This brings the total monetary request to three thousand five hundred dollars. - OTC

Thirdly, as we anticipate and look forward to our continued growth and expansion as a free food distribution Florida charity, along with the many other services which we provide free of charge within the community, we are requesting a county building at the lease rate of one dollar per year.

Your prompt and favorable attention and resolution to our request is greatly appreciated.


