



RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI  
CO-DESIGNATION OF SW 74<sup>TH</sup> STREET FROM SW 57<sup>TH</sup>  
AVENUE TO SW 61<sup>ST</sup> AVENUE AS “RICHARD O’BARRY  
DRIVE”

**WHEREAS**, Richard O’Barry was a dolphin trainer at the Miami Seaquarium during the 1960s, training the dolphins that performed in the movie Flipper; and

**WHEREAS**, after leaving the Seaquarium, O’Barry has been involved in the fight to free dolphins from captivity and in raising awareness to prevent cruelty to dolphins worldwide; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1991, O’Barry received the “Environmental Award” presented by the U.S. Committee for the United Nations Environmental Program (US/UNEP); and

**WHEREAS**, O’Barry has published two books, “Behind the Dolphin Smile” and “To Free a Dolphin”, both related to his work in saving dolphins; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 2, 2010, the City of South Miami Mayor and Commission adopted Resolution No. 117-10-13151, which designated SW 74<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue as “Richard O’Barry Drive,” in recognition of his contributions to the City of South Miami, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 74<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue is a city street located in the City of South Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of South Miami has requested that the County install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 7,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the City of South Miami co-designation of SW 74<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue as “Richard O’Barry Drive”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of South Miami, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 117-10-13151

**A Resolution of the Mayor and City Commission of the City of South Miami, Florida, Co-Designating S.W. 74<sup>th</sup> Street, from S.W. 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Red Road) to S.W. 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue as Richard O'Barry Drive; Directing the City Manager to submit this Resolution to Miami-Dade County and to take all other necessary actions to carry out the purpose of this Resolution; and providing an effective date.**

Whereas, Richard O'Barry is a resident of South Miami; and

Whereas, Richard O'Barry was a dolphin trainer in the Miami Seaquarium during the 1960's training the dolphins who performed in the movie Flipper, and

Whereas, after leaving the employ of the Seaquarium, Richard O'Barry has fought to free dolphins from captivity and raised awareness to prevent cruelty to dolphins in Japan and worldwide, and

Whereas, in 1991 O'Barry received the 'Environmental Achievement Award' presented by the United States Committee for the United Nations Environmental Program (US/UNEP) in recognition of his efforts to save dolphins, and

Whereas, O'Barry has published two books, "Behind the Dolphin Smile" and "To Free a Dolphin" concerning his work with saving dolphins, and

Whereas, the City Commission appreciates all efforts made by O'Barry to save dolphins.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** S.W. 74<sup>th</sup> Street, from S.W. 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Red Road) to S.W. 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue shall be co-designated as "Richard O'Barry Drive", and that it shall, as soon as authorized by Miami Dade County, be known in and by the City of

South Miami as "Richard O'Barry Drive", and signs shall be made and installed above the present street declaring that designation.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be provided to the US Postal Service and to the appropriate agencies to co-designate S.W. 74<sup>th</sup> Street, from S.W. 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Red Road) to S.W. 61<sup>st</sup> Avenue as "Richard O'Barry Drive".

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


