RESOLUTION SETTING POLICY FOR MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, REQUIRING EVERY ITEM CONSIDERED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT INCREASES A COUNTY FEE, FINE OR OTHER CHARGE TO TAXPAYERS AND OTHER USERS OF COUNTY FACILITIES AND SERVICES TO CLEARLY IDENTIFY SUCH INCREASE

**WHEREAS**, in addition to property tax revenue, Miami-Dade County generates a significant amount of revenue for County operations through fees at County facilities and for County services; and

**WHEREAS**, these fees include a wide range of County facilities and service, from parking fees at various County facilities, to solid waste fees, to fees for building permits, to various fees at the airports and seaport; and

**WHEREAS**, such fees help to lower property taxes by imposing fees on the individuals who are using a particular County facility or service; and

**WHEREAS**, while fee increases are sometimes necessary to keep pace with the cost of properly maintaining facilities and providing services, such fee increases nonetheless can have a significant impact on the families and small businesses that have to pay them, especially during these difficult economic times; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important that the Board carefully consider impacts to families and small businesses before approving fee increases,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that every item considered by the Board of County Commissioners that increases a County fee>>, fine or other charge<<<sup>1</sup> to taxpayers or other users of County facilities and services shall:

- (a) In the case of Administration items, clearly identify such increase in a separate section of the accompanying justification memorandum, or
- (b) In the case of a commissioner-sponsored item, clearly identify such increase in a separate whereas clause.
