We, the undersigned, County Court Judge SHELLEY J. KRAVITZ, **Chairperson**, County Court Judge, NORMA S. LINDSEY, **Substitute Member**, and Supervisor of Elections LESTER SOLA, **Member**, constituting the Board of County Canvassers in and for said County, do hereby certify that we met on the 31st day of August, A.D., 2010, and proceeded to publicly canvass the votes cast for the charter amendment questions herein specified at the **North Miami Special Election** held on the 24th day of August, A.D., 2010, as shown by the returns on file in the office of the Supervisor of Elections. We do hereby certify from said returns as follows:

**Section 5. Number; selection; term.  
Question 1**

The Charter currently provides that council members may serve for four (4) year terms without term limits. It is proposed the Charter be amended to provide that council members continue to serve four (4) year terms but commencing with the 2013 election and thereafter that they are limited to two (2) consecutive terms for a total of eight (8) years.

Shall the above-described Charter Amendment be adopted?

**Section 5. Number; selection; term.  
Question 2**

The Charter currently provides the Mayor may serve two (2) consecutive two (2) year terms totaling four (4) years. It is proposed that, commencing with the 2013 election, the Mayor may serve two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms totaling eight (8) years.

Shall the above-described Charter Amendment be adopted?

**Section 208. City Clerk; election**

The Charter currently provides the clerk shall be elected for a term of four (4) years without term limits. It is proposed the Charter be amended to provide that the Clerk continue to serve four (4) year terms but beginning in 2013 and thereafter s/he is limited to two (2) consecutive terms for a total of eight (8) years.

Shall the above-described Charter Amendment be adopted?
