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

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE CO-DESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF N.W. 93RD STREET BETWEEN N.W. 22ND AVENUE AND N.W. 27TH AVENUE/STATE ROAD 9 IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AS "PASTOR DR. CARL JOHNSON STREET"

WHEREAS, during the 2010 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed HB 1033, which co-designated that portion of N.W. 93rd Street between N.W. 22nd Avenue and N.W. 27th Avenue/State Road 9 as "Pastor Dr. Carl Johnson Street"; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Rev. Pastor Carl Johnson is the pastor of 93rd Street Community Baptist Church located at 2330 NW 93rd Street Miami, FL; and

WHEREAS, under the leadership of Dr. Rev. Pastor Carl Johnson, the 93rd Street Community Church has served the community in many ways including, but not limited to, providing financial assistance on a yearly basis to students through the church's College Aid Ministry and providing donated foods to families that are in need on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS that portion of N.W. 93rd Street between N.W. 22nd Avenue and N.W. 27th Avenue/State Road 9 is a state road located in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

WHEREAS, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 2,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the state road co-designation of that portion of N.W. 93rd Street between N.W. 22 Avenue and N.W. 27 Avenue/State Road 9 as “Pastor Dr. Carl Johnson Street.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation and the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department.
