RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO
PROVIDE MONTHLY REPORTS ON THE HIRING OF
EMPLOYEES BY EULEN AMERICA AND SWISSPORT FOR
FIS BAGGAGE HANDLING SERVICES AT MIAMI
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, baggage handling services in the FIS areas were being provided by Quality Aircraft Services under a contract with Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Quality Aircraft Services employees have years of experience providing these services at Miami International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Quality Aircraft Services' contract expired on October 1, 2010, and cannot be extended; and

WHEREAS, the airlines using Miami International Airport are now providing baggage handling services in the FIS areas of Miami International Airport, and have retained Eulen America and Swissport to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, Quality Aircraft Services employees, given their years of experience at Miami International Airport, should be given the opportunity to be hired by Eulen America or Swissport; and

WHEREAS, Eulen America and Swissport have indicated that they intend to hire as many former Quality Aircraft Services employees as possible,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee is directed to provide monthly reports to the Board of County Commissioners and the Airport and Seaport Committee regarding hiring practices of Eulen America and

Swissport (collectively, the “providers”) with respect to the provision of baggage handling services in the FIS areas of Miami International Airport, which report shall specifically include: (1) all open positions currently available with the providers, (2) the wage and benefits associated with each such position, (3) where such position are advertised to the public, (4) all recently filled positions with the providers, and (5) the number of former employees of Quality Aircraft Services who applied for such filled position, (6) whether such position was in fact filled with a former employee of Quality Aircraft Services, and (7) the wage and benefits provided for the filled position. Additionally, the County Mayor or Mayor’s designee is directed to prepare a plan for the resumption of baggage handling services in the FIS areas by the County, and to provide a report on such plan within 180 days.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dorrin D. Rolle. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
