Subject: Resolution Authorizing the Transfer of a Portion of a County Owned Right-of-Way for SW 72 Avenue also known as Parcel No. 100, to the Florida Department of Transportation for Improvements to State Road No. 976 (SW 40 Street)
Section: 14-54-40 Commission District 6

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the transfer of a portion of the right-of-way for SW 72 Avenue, also known as Parcel No. 100, to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for improvements to State Road No. 976 (SW 40 Street) and authorize the Mayor to execute a County Deed conveying in fee simple to FDOT the subject parcel.

Scope

The property to be conveyed is located within Commission District 6.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The Property Appraiser's Office has assessed the adjacent property to this right-of-way at \$65.00 per square foot. Therefore, the estimated value of this right-of-way would be approximately \$79,820.00. Conveying this portion of right-of-way will not result in an increase in revenue from property taxes because land used as right-of-way is tax-exempt; however, there is a positive fiscal impact from PWD no longer being responsible for the maintenance of the subject parcel.

Track Record/Monitor

Background

FDOT is planning improvements at the intersection of State Road 976 (SW 40 Street) and SW 72 Avenue. This project will upgrade existing roadway features to meet safety standards, including reconstruction of the pedestrian ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards.

The subject parcel is located in the northwest quadrant of the intersection of SW 40 Street and SW 72 Avenue. This parcel is needed for the installation of a railroad control shed. Additionally, sidewalks, curbs and gutters will be replaced and pedestrian ramps will be reconstructed. The planned improvements to this intersection will benefit vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the area. The Public Works Department (PWD) has no objection to this right-of-way being transferred.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A PORTION OF COUNTY OWNED RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR SW 72 AVENUE ALSO KNOWN AS PARCEL NO. 100 TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS OF STATE ROAD NO. 976 (SW 40 STREET), AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COUNTY DEED CONVEYING SAID PARCEL TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THEREOF, IN SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST

WHEREAS, the Board desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum, copies of which are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation proposes to construct and improve State Road No. 976 (SW 40 Street) in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, a portion of County owned right-of-way for SW 72 Avenue, also known as Parcel No. 100 is needed for the proposed improvements to said State Road No. 976; and

WHEREAS, the Board is satisfied that Parcel No. 100 is needed for such public interest; and

WHEREAS, the subject Property will revert to the County in the event that use for transportation purposes ever ceases,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, 1) that the foregoing recitals are incorporated and adopted herein, 2) that this Board, pursuant to Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, authorizes the conveyance of Parcel No. 100 to the Florida Department of

Transportation, as shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof for no monetary consideration, (3) that this Board authorizes the County Mayor to execute a County Deed on behalf of Miami-Dade County, in substantially the form attached hereto, conveying Parcel No. 100 in fee simple to the Florida Department of Transportation; (4) that the procedure utilized in the adoption of this resolution is expressly ratified and approved; and (5) the Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the adoption of this resolution one (1) time within thirty (30) days hereafter in a newspaper of general circulation of Miami-Dade County.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



THIS DEED, Made this _____ day of _____, A.D. 2010, by and between **MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is: Metro-Dade Center, 111 N.W. 1st Street, Miami, Florida 33128-1963, party of the first part, and the **FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, whose address is 1000 NW 111th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33172, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH:

THAT the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to it in hand paid by the party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the said party of the second part, its successors, and assigns forever, the following described land lying and being in Miami-Dade County, Florida:

SEE EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF.

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Subject to the following restriction:

That the Property shall be utilized for transportation related improvements to State Road No. 976 (SW 40 Street). Failure to utilize the Property for said purpose shall result in the Property automatically reverting to the party of the first part.

This grant conveys only the interest of the County and its Board of County Commissioners in the property herein described, and shall not be deemed to warrant the title or to represent any state of facts concerning the same.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION PARCEL 100

EXHIBIT "A"

Being a parcel of land lying within the right-of-way of Southwest 72nd Avenue (Avenue P), according to the Plat of CENTRAL MIAMI PART SIX, as recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 8, and lying in the Southeast one-quarter (1/4) of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 14, Township 54 South, Range 40 East, all in Miami-Dade County, Florida, and being more particularly described as follows:


Commence at the Southeast corner of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of said Section 14, lying at the intersection of the baseline of survey of State Road 976 (Bird Road / Southwest 40th Street) and the baseline of Southwest 72nd Avenue, as shown on the Florida Department of Transportation Project Survey Control, Project No. 424544-1-52-01, Dated 04/21/2008; thence N 02°24'27" W, along said baseline of Southwest 72nd Avenue and the East line of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of aforementioned Section 14, a distance of 50.00 feet to the intersection with the Easterly prolongation of the Northerly Right-of-Way line of State Road 976 (Southwest 40th street / Bird Road) as shown on the Florida Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Map, Section 87520-2601 (87044), last revised September 1971; thence S 87°54'13" W, along lastly said line, a distance of 36.40 feet to the intersection with the Westerly Right-of-Way line of the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad, and the POINT OF BEGINNING of the following described parcel:

Thence continue S 87°54'13" W along lastly said line, a distance of 57.15 feet to the point of cusp with a curve concave to the northwest having a radius of 25.00 feet, the chord of which bears N 43°13'19" E; thence Northeasterly and Northerly along the arc of said curve a distance of 38.99 feet through a central angle of 89°21'46"; thence N 87°54'13" E, non-tangent to last described curve, a distance of 21.75 feet; thence N 02°05'47" W a distance of 22.70 feet; thence N 87°54'13" E a distance of 13.06 feet to the intersection with the aforesaid Westerly Right-of-Way line of the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad; thence S 01°07'03" W, along said Westerly Right-of-Way line, a distance of 47.50 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing 1,228 square feet, more or less.


