Recommendation

The attached Amendment No. 1 in the amount of \$698,631.00, on a contract between Bermello, Ajamil & Partners, Inc. and Miami-Dade County, has been prepared by the General Services Administration and is recommended for approval.

AMENDMENT NUMBER: 1

BACKGROUND: On April 29, 2009, the award recommendation for the contract with Bermello, Ajamil & Partners, Inc. for the design services for the renovation of the Joseph Caleb Center, New Courthouse Annex/Additions, and New Parking Garage was executed by the Clerk of the Board.

During the construction documents phase of the Courthouse, the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) requested that an additional 10,000 square feet of shell space be constructed in two floors; the first floor will house future support space for the courthouse and the second floor will house a future courtroom.

Additionally, the existing Joseph Caleb Center Atrium is in need of improvements in order to connect the existing facility to the new Annex and Parking Garage. The revised scope of work includes enclosure of the First Floor Lobby to protect users from inclement weather, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system upgrades, fire alarm system, replacement of the front entrance canopy, and refurbishment to existing floor lobbies.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The original scope of services consisted of architectural and engineering design services for the addition of a new Courthouse Annex, which will house new courtrooms, offices and supporting spaces/areas under 25,000 square feet of constructed area. During the design development phase, the constructed area was increased to 27,864 sq. ft.

The project also included the design of a new, 190,000 square-foot Parking Garage with 475-parking spaces, which will be fully prepared for future installation of an entry/exit booth(s) and control gate(s), as well as to provide secured spaces on the ground floor for Court officials.

This project is subject to the Miami-Dade County Zoning regulations, and must be designed to obtain a minimum rating of "Silver" per the Miami-Dade County Sustainability Ordinance (Chapter 9, Article III, Sections 9-71 thru 9-75 of the County Code) and the Green Building Council's (USGBC) Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Rating System.

FUNDING SOURCE: This PSA was be funded as follows: a) the design of the new Courthouse Annex/Additions to the Caleb Center will be funded through the Capital Outlay Reserve (COR) in the amount of \$919,450.00; b) the design of the new Parking Garage serving the Caleb Center will be funded through the Building Better Communities - General Obligation Bonds (GOB) in the amount of \$883,391.00.

AMENDMENT FUNDING SOURCE: This Amendment will be funded as follows: a) the changes to the Courthouse Annex/Additions to the Caleb Center will be funded through the Capital Outlay Reserve (COR) in the amount of \$292,719.00; b) the changes to the Parking Garage serving the Caleb Center will be funded through the Building Better Communities - General Obligation Bonds (GOB), GOB Project No. 231 (Site #70306) in the amount of \$405,912.00.

AMENDMENT DESCRIPTION: The scope of work covered by this amendment includes, but will not be limited to, the following:

1) Expansion to the Courthouse Annex/Additions: research, planning, design, specifications, construction documents, permitting, bidding and award, and construction administration services. The expansion requested by the AOC will represent an additional 10,000 square feet of constructed area in two floors, in addition to the original 27,864 square feet.

2) Improvements to the Atrium at the existing Joseph Caleb Center: on-site field verification services. The improvements to the existing atrium will include enclosure of the First Floor Lobby with impact glass and structural improvements as required to accomplish the installation of new HVAC system, lighting, fire sprinkler and fire alarm systems to the atrium. The existing west front entrance canopy to the atrium will be replaced and new finishes will be introduced throughout the atrium and its associated areas.

3) Replenishment of Contingency Allowance: full replenishment of the original \$141,857.00 Contingency Allowance Account, according to the Professional Services Agreement in place. Out of the original contingency allowance account, \$44,777.00 was utilized to pay for a required Water Main Extension (\$24,677.00 for the design, preparation of CDs, permitting and Consultant's attendance to meetings with the Public Works Department and \$20,100.00 was utilized to pay for a Left turn lane Reconfiguration for the design, preparation of CDs, permitting and Consultant's attendance to meetings. All this work was necessary for the Water Main Extension); and \$97,080.00 was paid to the Consultant for work performed towards the future courtroom expansion.

MONETARY JUSTIFICATION: In order to address the recommended expansion and improvements, the amount of \$556,774.00 will be required. This amount is comprised of the following line items:

1) \$217,534.00 for the expansion to the Courthouse Annex/Additions: The fees for the design work include a contingency allowance of 10%. The construction cost for the additional space is estimated at \$2,700,000.00.

2) \$339,240.00 for improvements to the Atrium at the existing Joseph Caleb Center, to include a bridge connector to and from the parking garage: The fees for the design work include a contingency allowance of 10%. The construction cost for these improvements is estimated at \$2,400,000.00.

TIMES JUSTIFICATION: No additional time is required as part of this amendment.

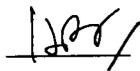

YOU ARE HEREBY REQUESTED TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THIS PROJECT AND TO PERFORM THE WORK ACCORDINGLY, SUBJECT TO ALL CONTRACT STIPULATIONS AND COVENANTS.

Description of work authorized: The scope of work covered by this amendment includes, but will not be limited to, the following:
 1) Expansion to the Courthouse Annex/Additions: research, planning, design, specifications, construction documents, permitting, bidding and award, and construction administration services. The expansion requested by the AOC will represent an additional 10,000 square feet of constructed area in two floors, in addition to the original 27,864 square feet. (Continued below)

Monetary Justification: In order to address the recommended expansion and improvements, the amount of \$556,774.00 will be required. This amount is comprised of the following line items:
 1) \$217,534.00 for the expansion to the Courthouse Annex /Additions: The fees for the design work include a contingency allowance of 10%. The construction cost for the additional space is estimated at \$2,700,000.00. (Continued below)

Time Justification: No additional time is required as part of this amendment.

This amendment includes not only all direct costs of contractor such as labor, material, job overhead, and profit markup; but also includes any costs for modifications or changes in sequence of work to be performed, delays, rescheduling, disruption, extended direct overhead or general overhead, acceleration, material or other escalation which include wages and other impact costs.

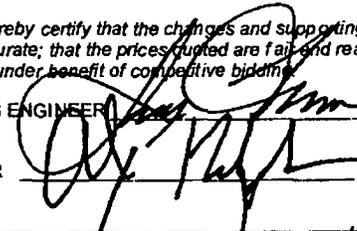
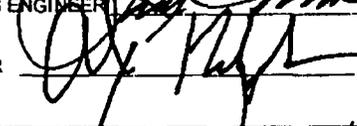

Description of work authorized: (Continued)

2) Improvements to the Atrium at the existing Joseph Caleb Center: on-site field verification services. The improvements to the existing atrium will include enclosure of the First Floor Lobby with impact glass and structural improvements as required to accomplish the installation of new HVAC system, lighting, fire sprinkler and fire alarm systems to the atrium. The existing west front entrance canopy to the atrium will be replaced and new finishes will be introduced throughout the atrium and its associated areas.

3) Replenishment of Contingency Allowance: full replenishment of the original \$141,857.00 Contingency Allowance Account, according to the Professional Services Agreement in place. Out of the original contingency allowance account, \$44,777.00 was utilized to pay for a required Water Main Extension (\$24,677.00 for the design, preparation of CDs, permitting and Consultant's attendance to meetings with the Public Works Department); \$20,100.00 was utilized to pay for a Left turn lane Reconfiguration for the design, preparation of CDs, permitting and Consultant's attendance to meetings; and \$97,080.00 was paid to the Consultant for work performed towards the future courtroom expansion.

Monetary Justification: (Continued)

2) \$339,240.00 for improvements to the Atrium at the existing Joseph Caleb Center, to include a bridge connector to and from the parking garage: The fees for the design work include a contingency allowance of 10%. The construction cost for these improvements is estimated at \$2,400,000.00.

Time Justification Declaration:

A time extension is provided for additional work performed outside the scope of the original Contract that affects the critical path schedule of the contracted work or previously approved changes. Should additional work be required which does not affect the critical path schedule, no time extension will be granted. Should one item of additional work run concurrent with another item of additional work, only time not duplicated can be provided.

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
