

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE STANDARDIZATION OF
CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND PRACTICES

WHEREAS, each department of Miami-Dade County with capital construction responsibilities has used its own documents for the bidding, letting and of construction contracts; and

WHEREAS, each such department has also followed its own construction practices; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a uniform standard for construction documents and practices will promote greater efficiency and enhance the County's ability to make uniform decisions and to gather and process construction information, and will reduce claims and provide the County with better tools to defend against them; and

WHEREAS, the handling of bids in a uniform manner will promote efficiency, reduce the number of late bids, and provide for greater transparency,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Mayor or Mayor's designee is hereby directed to standardize construction documents, including but not limited to invitations to bid, bid forms and forms of change order, throughout the County's capital construction departments. Where the department engages in specialized construction, the same shall be handled wherever possible through the use of special conditions of contract. The Mayor or Mayor's designee is further directed to standardize construction practices related to such documents, including but not limited to record

keeping, scheduling and invoicing. To implement this resolution, the Mayor or Mayor’s designee shall receive the advice of the major County contracting departments.

Section 2. The Mayor or Mayor’s designee shall report to this Board all actions taken to implement this resolution within sixty (60) days from its effective date.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
