RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WAIVER OF PLAT OF CANADA DRY BOTTLING CO. OF FLORIDA, INC., D-23149, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY APPROXIMATELY NW 61 STREET, ON THE EAST BY NW 72 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY APPROXIMATELY NW 58 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY NW 74 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, Canada Dry Bottling Co. of Florida, Inc., a Florida corporation, has this day presented to this Board a waiver of plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said waiver of plat of the property legally described as a portion of Tracts 17 and 18 of the "Amended Plat of Section 14, Township 53 South, Range 40 East", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 8, at Page 16, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 14, Township 53 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said waiver of plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

plat conforms to those requirements; this approval is conditioned upon the proper execution of all documents required by the County Attorney's Office.



