RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO APPLY \$1,000,000 IN CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SURTAX FUNDS TOWARDS THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS AT OR NEAR THE UNIVERSITY METRORAIL STATION

WHEREAS, funds for the proposed pedestrian overpasses at the Dadeland North, Dadeland South, and South Miami Metrorail Stations were deleted and reprogrammed towards the design and construction of a pedestrian overpass at University Metrorail Station; and

WHEREAS, even with the aforementioned reprogramming of funds, there appears to be a \$1,000,000 funding shortfall for the engineering and construction of the pedestrian overpass at the University Metrorail Station; and

WHEREAS, an expedited identification of a funding source to fill the gap of this matter will assist in the application for State matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the development of a pedestrian overpass to provide safe passage to and from a Metrorail station is an eligible expense for Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds; and

WHEREAS, the specific area designated for the University Station overpass is especially needed to ensure the safety of students, employees, and visitors to business and educational facilities, including the University of Miami and Ponce de Leon Middle School,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby

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directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to apply \$1,000,000 in Charter County

Transportation Surtax Funds towards the design and construction of a pedestrian overpass at or

near the University Metrorail Station.
