

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF NW 16th AVENUE FROM NW 3rd
STREET TO NW 7th STREET AS "MARLINS WAY"

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2010, the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution R-10-0485, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, which codesignated NW 16th Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 7th Street as "Marlins Way"; and

WHEREAS, NW 16th Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 7th Street is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of NW 16th Avenue from NW 3rd Street to NW 7th Street as "Marlins Way."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING NORTHWEST 16TH AVENUE FROM NORTHWEST 3RD STREET TO NORTHWEST 7TH STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "MARLINS WAY;" FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INSTRUCT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Northwest 16th Avenue from Northwest 3rd Street to Northwest 7th Street, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Marlins Way".

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to instruct the Director of Public Works to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, Miami-Dade County Public Works, and the United States Postal Service.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}
