RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF THE CONNECTING DRIVEWAY
ALIGNING, MORE OR LESS, WITH NW 4TH STREET
BETWEEN NW 14TH AVENUE TO NW 16TH AVENUE AS
“BOBBY MADURO DRIVE”

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2010, the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution R-10-0484, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, which codesignated the connecting driveway aligning more or less with NW 4th Street between NW 14th Avenue to NW 16th Avenue as “Bobby Maduro Drive” in recognition of his contributions to the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, Bobby Maduro was born in Havana, Cuba in 1916, was a wealthy businessman who owned a bus line, an insurance company, sugar fields and cattle, and was the owner of the Havana Sugar Kings, an International League baseball franchise in the 1950s; and

WHEREAS, Bobby Maduro passed away in 1986; and

WHEREAS, Miami Stadium, the home of several minor league teams and major league spring training, was renamed Bobby Maduro Miami Stadium in 1987; and

WHEREAS, the connecting driveway aligning more or less with NW 4th Street between NW 14th Avenue to NW 16th Avenue is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of the connecting driveway aligning more or less with NW 4th Street between NW 14th Avenue to NW 16th Avenue as “Bobby Maduro Drive.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department.
