Subject: Resolution Authorizing Release of Surplus Tax Deed 07-736 Sale Proceeds
in the amount of \$117,144.03

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution authorizing release of Surplus Tax Deed 07-736 sale proceeds in the amount of \$117,144.03 to Smith, Hiatt and Diaz, P.A., Trust Account for the benefit of Countrywide Home Loans, Inc. who was a lienholder and is entitled to the excess proceeds.

Scope

The attached resolution authorizes release of surplus tax deed sale proceeds in accordance with provisions of the Florida Statutes. The property is located in Commission District 8.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the County. All property taxes owed were collected at the time of tax certificates being sold and/or at time of the tax deed sale. Surplus funds result from net proceeds of the tax deed sale

Background

Miami-Dade County presently holds \$117,144.03 in excess proceeds from the sale of a tax deed for delinquent taxes on or about April 10, 2008 on the property described as follows:

Pursuant to Section 197.582, Florida Statutes, said excess undistributed funds are retained for the benefit of the person who, on the date of the sale, was the titleholder of record and for lien holders.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the surplus funds be released to Smith, Hiatt and Diaz, P.A., Trust Account, for the benefit of Countrywide Home Loans, Inc., a lienholder judicially determined to be entitled to said proceeds.

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Circuit Court issued a tax deed for delinquent taxes upon the following described real property on or about April 10, 2008,
