Subject: Extension of Food Catering Services

RECOMMENDATION

On January 11, 2011, the Internal Management and Fiscal Responsibility Committee (Committee) approved a motion to defer the County Manager's recommendation to award a new contract for food catering services for the elderly (Agenda Item 3L). The Committee deferred the item until the February 8, 2011 Committee meeting in order to allow staff time to address questions posed by Committee members. The current food catering services end on January 31, 2011. The Committee approved a motion to place an item for a 30 day extension on the January 20, 2011 Board of County Commission to ensure continuity of food catering services.

Therefore, it is recommended that the extension of food catering services be approved to begin on February 1, 2011. This action includes the services covered by three contracts which are being consolidated under the contract award recommendation presented to Committee on January 11, 2011. The extension will be based on current terms and conditions. The services will continue to be provided by Construction Catering Inc, the incumbent vendor until February 28, 2011.

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
