

THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CHIEF ECONOMIST AS THE
OFFICIAL LIAISON FOR STAFF SUPPORT TO THE SOCIAL
AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Social and Economic Development Council (SEDC) for Miami-Dade County is charged with making findings and recommendations to the Mayor of Miami-Dade County and the Board of County Commissioners regarding necessary measures to ensure full recovery and future socioeconomic development; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Economist for Miami-Dade County works within the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT) and is charged with analyzing, reporting and making policy recommendations based on economic data; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 10-60 created the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT) and authorized OEDIT to staff and support the Social Economic Development Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor is requested to designate the Miami-Dade County Chief Economist as the official liaison for staff support to the Social and Economic Development Council (SEDC).
