RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SB 522; HB 299 OR SIMILAR
LEGISLATION ALLOWING BINGO TO BE PLAYED AT
PARI-MUTUEL FACILITIES; URGING THE FLORIDA
LEGISLATURE TO PASS SUCH LEGISLATION

WHEREAS, bills have been filed for consideration during the 2011 session that would authorize bingo to be played at existing facilities designated as cardrooms, SB 522 by Senator Miguel Diaz de la Portilla (R – Miami) and HB 299 by Representative Erik Fresen (R – Miami); and

WHEREAS, these bills would allow bingo to be played at the four existing pari-mutuel facilities in Miami-Dade County, with 80 percent of all proceeds from bingo games during the year to be returned to the players in the form of prizes and cash awards; and

WHEREAS, the addition of bingo games would create an estimated 100 jobs at each pari-mutuel facility, and there has never been a time when our community needs jobs more than now; and

WHEREAS, allowing bingo would not be an expansion of gambling, but simply would authorize existing pari-mutuels to offer an additional game; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to express its support for SB 522 and HB 299 and urges the Florida Legislature to pass such legislation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Supports SB 522; HB 299 or similar legislation allowing for bingo games at pari-mutuel facilities.

Section 2. Urges the Florida Legislature to pass SB 522; HB 299 or similar legislation.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, Senator Miguel Diaz de la Portilla, Representative Erik Fresen, the Chair and remaining Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation and the Secretary of the Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation.

Section 4. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the issue identified in sections 1 and 2 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2011 state legislative package.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
