

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DECEMBER 4, 2010 "BGBA TOY GIVEAWAY" SPONSORED BY BLACK GLOBAL BIKERS ASSOCIATION, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,600.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 1 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Black Global Bikers Association, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the December 4, 2010 "BGBA Toy Giveaway" in an amount not to exceed \$3,600.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "BGBA Toy Giveaway" is a toy giveaway for visually impaired and disabled children which includes music in the park; and

WHEREAS, Black Global Bikers Association, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "BGBA Toy Giveaway" is a small event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$3,600.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the unspent balance of the District 1 In-kind Reserve Fund,

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization, Black Global Bikers Association, Inc., for their "BGBA Toy Giveaway" event held on December 4, 2010.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$3,600 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a small showmobile, sound system and a 25 KW generator. This event will be funded from the unspent balance of the District 1 FY 2008-09 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2010-11, Black Global Bikers Association, Inc., received no funding for this event.

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
