Subject: Roy and Lea Black Foundation Grant for the Juvenile Services Department

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) ratify the County Mayor or the Mayor's designee's action in accepting grant funding from the Roy and Lea Black Foundation (Consequences Foundation) in the amount of \$60,000.00; for a public, privately funded partnership to provide services to juveniles through the Juvenile Services Department (JSD). It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to apply for, receive and expend grant funds, to execute such contracts, agreements, Memoranda of Understanding (MOU), amendments and renewals as required by program guidelines, and to apply for, receive, and expend additional funds that may become available. We are seeking retroactive approval due to the short period of time provided between the agreement to fund Miami-Dade County JSD and the initial disbursement of grant funds as determined by the funding agency.

Scope

The Miami Dade County Juvenile Services Department (JSD) will integrate evidence-based juvenile assessment and intervention services and integrate the Consequences Foundation Curriculum for youth at risk of committing a juvenile offense and youth who have already committed a juvenile offense. The Consequences Foundation Curriculum provides enhancements to JSD services and funding for Juveniles to receive needed services not previously available such as additional slots for treatment and counseling.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This grant will provide funds to enhance JSD's continuum of evidence-based services and to sustain delivery of those services. A match was not required, a revenue index code of JURCFF2010 will be utilized for revenue, and an expenditure code of JUECFF2010 will be utilized for expenditures.

Track Record/Monitor

Morris Copeland, Director of JSD will administer the grant funds, oversee the proposed plan and monitor the collecting of the corresponding data.

Background

Over the last eleven years, Miami-Dade County has engaged in juvenile justice reform and has documented a 46% reduction in juvenile arrests, an 80% reduction in re-arrests and a drop in the detention population from over 300 a day to approximately 100.

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The continued service to juveniles and the enhancement of services to clients is vital in continuing JSD's mission by utilizing evidence-based, nationally demonstrated, juvenile assessment, prevention, and intervention services.

This partnership with the Consequences Foundation will allow JSD's proven methods to reach even more children by providing additional funds for additional treatment slots, outreach, skill development, educational services, thus further expanding long term results.

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE'S ACTION IN APPLYING FOR AND ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ROY AND LEA BLACK FOUNDATIONS/ CONSEQUENCES FOUNDATION FOR THE CREATION OF A PUBLIC, PRIVATELY FUNDED PARTNERSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,000.00 FOR SERVICE TO JUVENILES THROUGH THE MIAMI-DADE JUVENILE SERVICES DEPARTMENT (JSD); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND SAID FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SUCH CONTRACTS, AGREEMENTS, AND MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING, AND AMENDMENTS AFTER REVIEW BY THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, RECEIVE AND EXPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS THAT MAY BECOME AVAILABLE

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board ratifies the Mayor or the Mayor's designee's action in applying for and accepting a grant award from the Roy and Lea Black Foundations/ Consequences Foundation in the amount of \$60,000.00; authorizes the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to receive and expend grant funds; authorizes the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to execute related contracts, agreements, Memoranda of Understanding (MOU), after review by the County Attorney's office; authorizes the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to file and execute any amendments to the grant application and to exercise amendments, modifications, renewals, and cancellation, and termination clauses of

any contracts and agreements, subject to review by the County Attorney's office; and authorizes the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to apply for, receive, and expend additional funds that may become available.
