RESOLUTION CALLING A COUNTYWIDE SPECIAL ELECTION IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, [_____], 2011, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY THE QUESTION OF WHETHER TO AMEND THE HOME RULE CHARTER TO PROVIDE, COMMENCING WITH THE COUNTY MAYOR AND COMMISSION ELECTIONS SCHEDULED FOR 2012, THAT NO PERSON WHO HAS SERVED EIGHT (8) YEARS AS AN ELECTED MUNICIPAL OR COUNTY OFFICER IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO QUALIFY AS A CANDIDATE FOR, NOR MAY BE ELECTED AS, MAYOR OR COUNTY COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 6 of the Florida Constitution provides that the electors of Miami-Dade County may impose limitations on the number of consecutive terms in office of the County Commission through the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, term limits will increase voter choice by allowing more candidates to participate in the democratic process in the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A countywide special election is hereby called and shall be held in Miami-Dade County, Florida on Tuesday, [_____], 2011, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Miami-Dade County the proposal for amendment to the Home Rule Charter in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. Notice of such election shall be published in accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. The result of such election shall be determined by a majority of the qualified electors of Miami-Dade County voting upon the proposal. The polls at such election

shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the day of such election. All qualified electors of Miami-Dade County, Florida shall be entitled to vote at said election. The County registration books shall remain open at the Office of the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections until twenty-nine (29) days prior to the date of such election, at which time the registration books will close in accordance with the provisions of general election laws. The question shall appear on the ballot in substantially the following form:

HOME RULE CHARTER AMENDMENT
ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION FOR
MAYOR AND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

SHALL THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE,
COMMENCING WITH THE COUNTY MAYOR AND
COMMISSION ELECTIONS SCHEDULED FOR 2012,
THAT NO PERSON WHO HAS SERVED EIGHT (8)
YEARS AS AN ELECTED MUNICIPAL OR COUNTY
OFFICER IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SHALL BE
ELIGIBLE TO QUALIFY AS A CANDIDATE FOR, NOR
MAY BE ELECTED AS, MAYOR OR COUNTY
COMMISSIONER?

Section 4. The form of the ballot shall be in accordance with the requirements of general election laws.

Section 5. Early voting shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of general election laws.

Section 6. Absentee paper ballots may be used by qualified electors of Miami-Dade County for voting on this question. The form of such absentee ballot shall be in accordance with the requirements prescribed by general election laws.

Section 7. A sample ballot showing the manner in which the question or proposal aforesaid will appear at this election shall be published and provided in accordance with the applicable provisions of general election laws.

Section 8. This special election on the proposal aforesaid shall be held and conducted in accordance with applicable provisions of the general laws relating to elections and the provisions of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter. The County Mayor or his or her designee, the Finance Director, and the Clerk of the County Commission are hereby authorized and directed to take all appropriate actions necessary to carry into effect and accomplish the provisions of this resolution. This election shall be a nonpartisan election. Election officials in connection with this election shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of general election laws.

Section 9. This election shall be canvassed by the County Canvassing Board, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.07 of the Home Rule Charter.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER

ARTICLE-3¹

ELECTIONS

**Section 3.01 ELECTION AND COMMENCEMENT
OF TERMS OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS.**

* * *

>>E. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Charter, beginning with the election of the Mayor and Commissioners scheduled to occur in 2012, no person who has served eight (8) or more years as an elected municipal or county officer in Miami-Dade County as of the calendar year in which qualification occurs shall be eligible to qualify as a candidate for, nor may be elected as, the Mayor or a County Commissioner.<<
