It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve award of this contract to the vendors listed below for purchase of uniforms and accessories for Miami-Dade Transit Department.

CONTRACT NUMBER: 9436-2/17
CONTRACT TITLE: Uniforms and Accessories for Miami-Dade Transit
TERM: Two years, with options-to-renew for two, two-year periods
APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE: November 2, 2010
METHOD OF AWARD: To the two responsive and responsible bidders offering the lowest aggregate price as primary and secondary vendors.
PREVIOUS CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$262,000 for a six-month term
CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$650,000 for a two-year term
*If the county chooses to exercise the two, two-year options-to-renew, the cumulative value will be \$ 1,950,000.

Global Trading Inc (Alternate Bid)	Rejected - The County Attorney's Office (CAO) opined that the alternate offer from Global Trading Inc. may be rejected by the County as the bidder failed to provide samples for evaluation purposes. (CAO opinion is attached)
IPA Corporation (Alternate Bid)	Rejected - Samples provided for the short and long sleeve poplin shirts were rejected as the fabric did not meet solicitation requirements.
Monica Manufacturing	Prices are higher than the recommended bidder

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BACKGROUND

This contract will be used by Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) for purchase of uniforms for bus and train operators, mechanics, and maintenance workers. The County is required to provide uniforms under the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the County and Transport Workers Union, Local 291. Items on this contract include, but are not limited to, pants, shorts, shirts, trousers, skirts, blazers, jackets, and shoes.

This long-term contract replaces two emergency contracts for purchase of uniforms. These emergency contracts were awarded to ensure continuity of service as the previously awarded vendor experienced difficulty in meeting the high demand for uniforms, and could no longer meet its contractual obligations. This long-term contract will allow MDT to continue to purchase adequate quantities of needed items.

Summary

This resolution awards Contract No. 9436-2/17: Uniforms and Accessories for Miami-Dade Transit, to Global Trading Inc., and IPA Corporation, in the amount of \$1.95 million and authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to execute the contracts and to exercise any renewal and cancellation provision.

Background

On October 2, 2007, under Resolution No. 1093-07, the Board of County Commissioners awarded Contract No. 8302-4/12, Uniforms for Bus and Train Operators and Supervisors, to RDH Quest in the amount of \$387,243 (\$274,943 in MDT operating funds and \$112,300 in PTP funds) for the initial one-year term. However, in April 2010, this contract was terminated due to outstanding back orders for uniforms. A total of \$17,439.12 was released to RDH Quest.

On July 20, 2010, under Resolution No. 811-10, the County ratified an emergency contract awarded for purchase of uniforms for MDT to Monica Manufacturing, Corp. in the amount of \$112,000.

Additionally, On October 5, 2010, under Resolution No. 984-10, another emergency contract, was awarded to Monica Manufacturing Corp. for \$150,000 for the initial 6 months term with one, six-month OTR period for a cumulative value of \$300,000.
